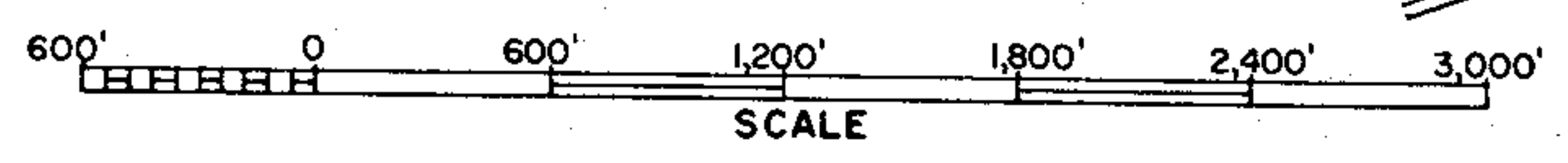


B.M. 'X' Top of northwest corner of southeast cement footing at entrance of boat house on west bay of south shore of lake.
