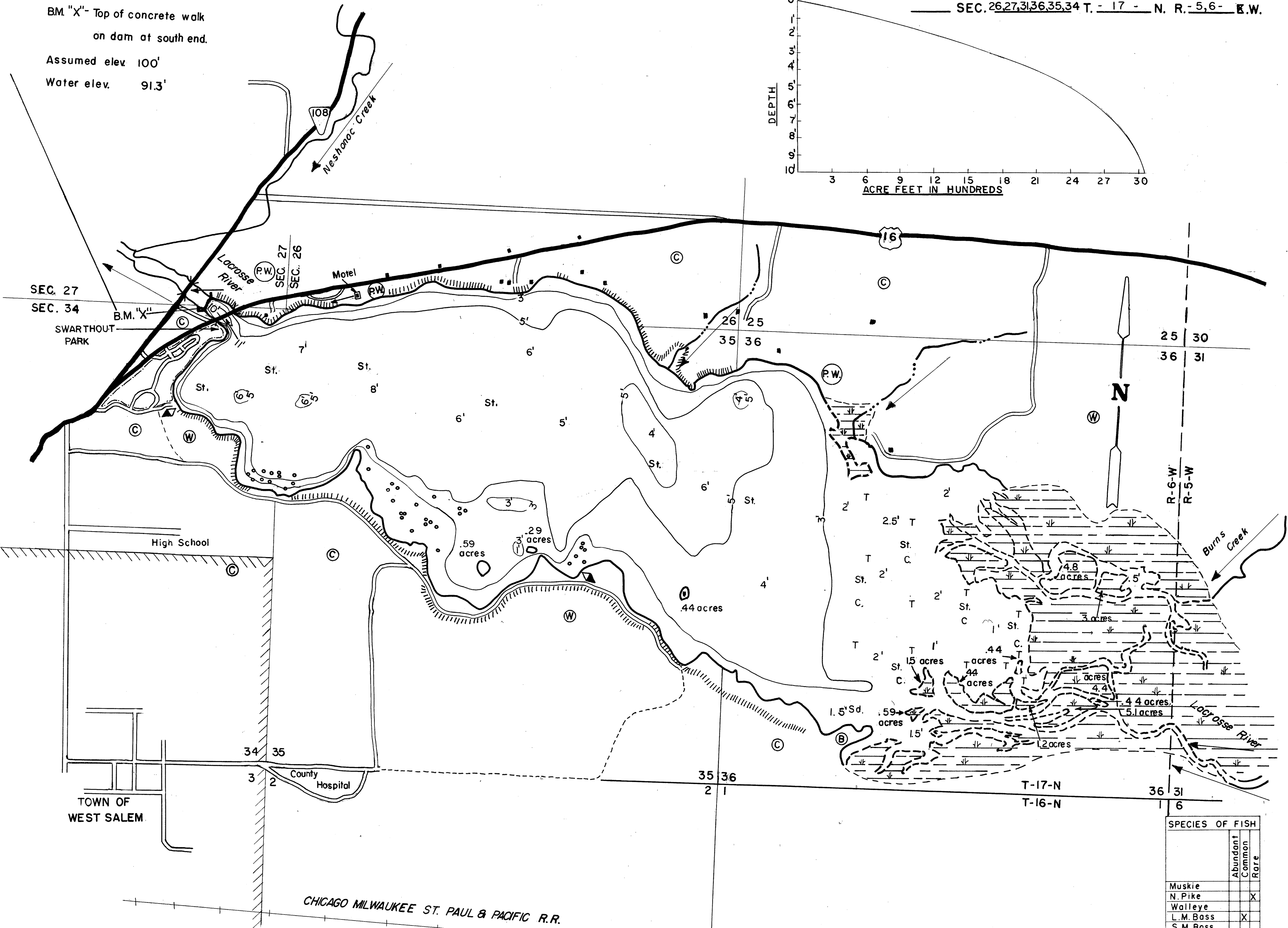
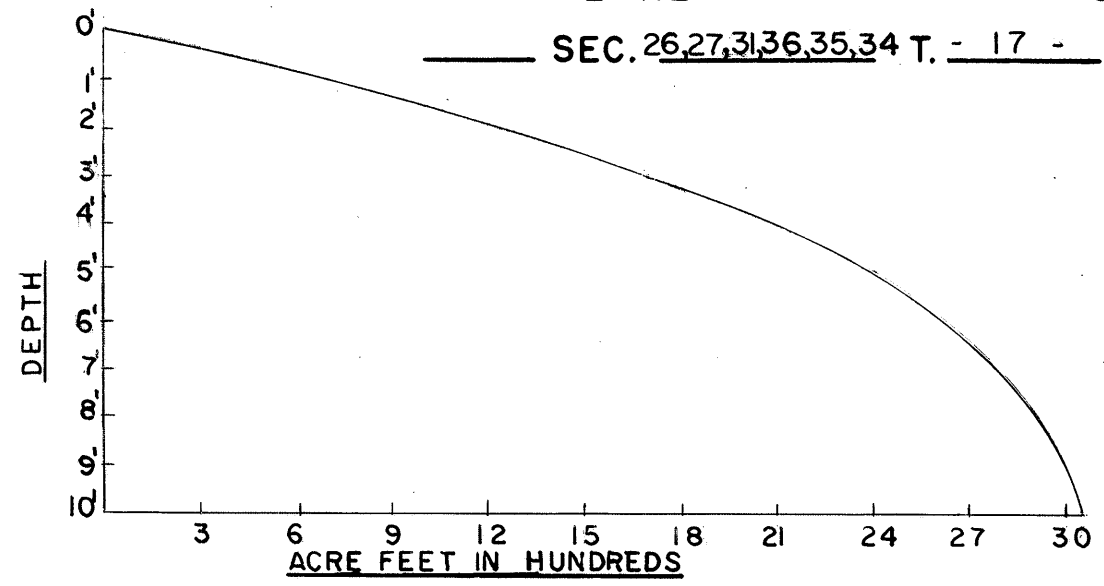


BM "X" - Top of concrete walk

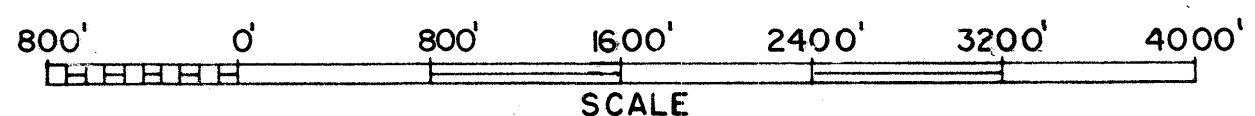
