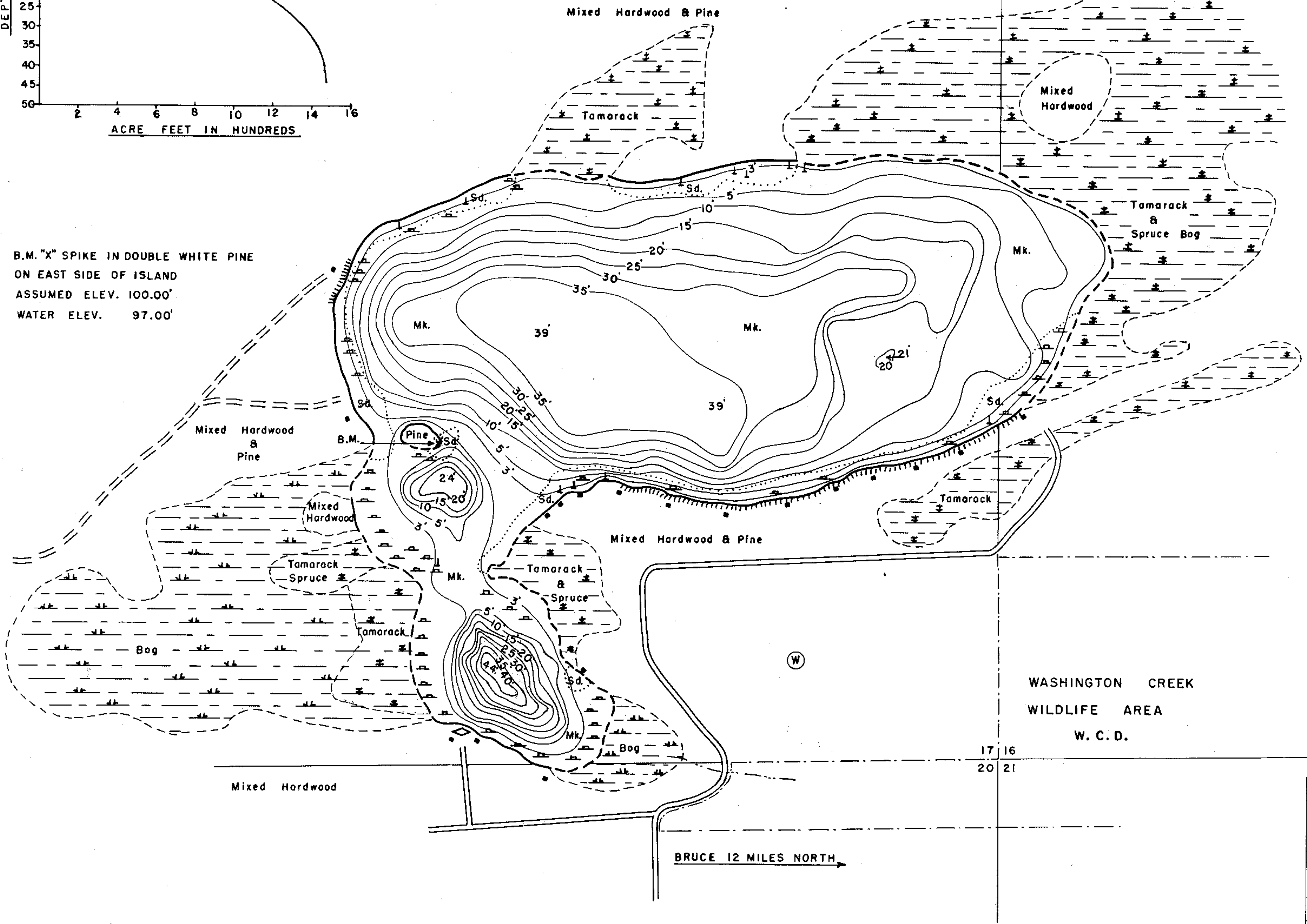


B.M. "X" SPIKE IN DOUBLE WHITE PINE

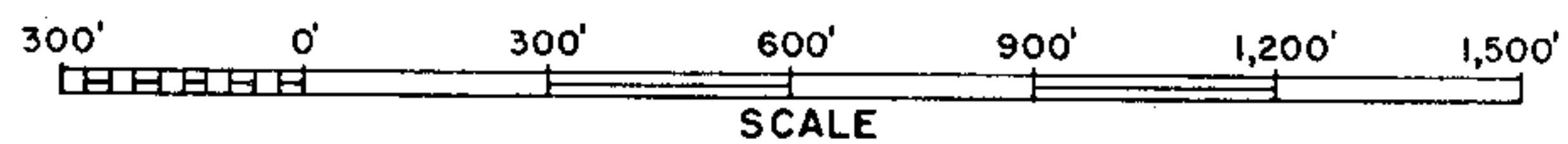
