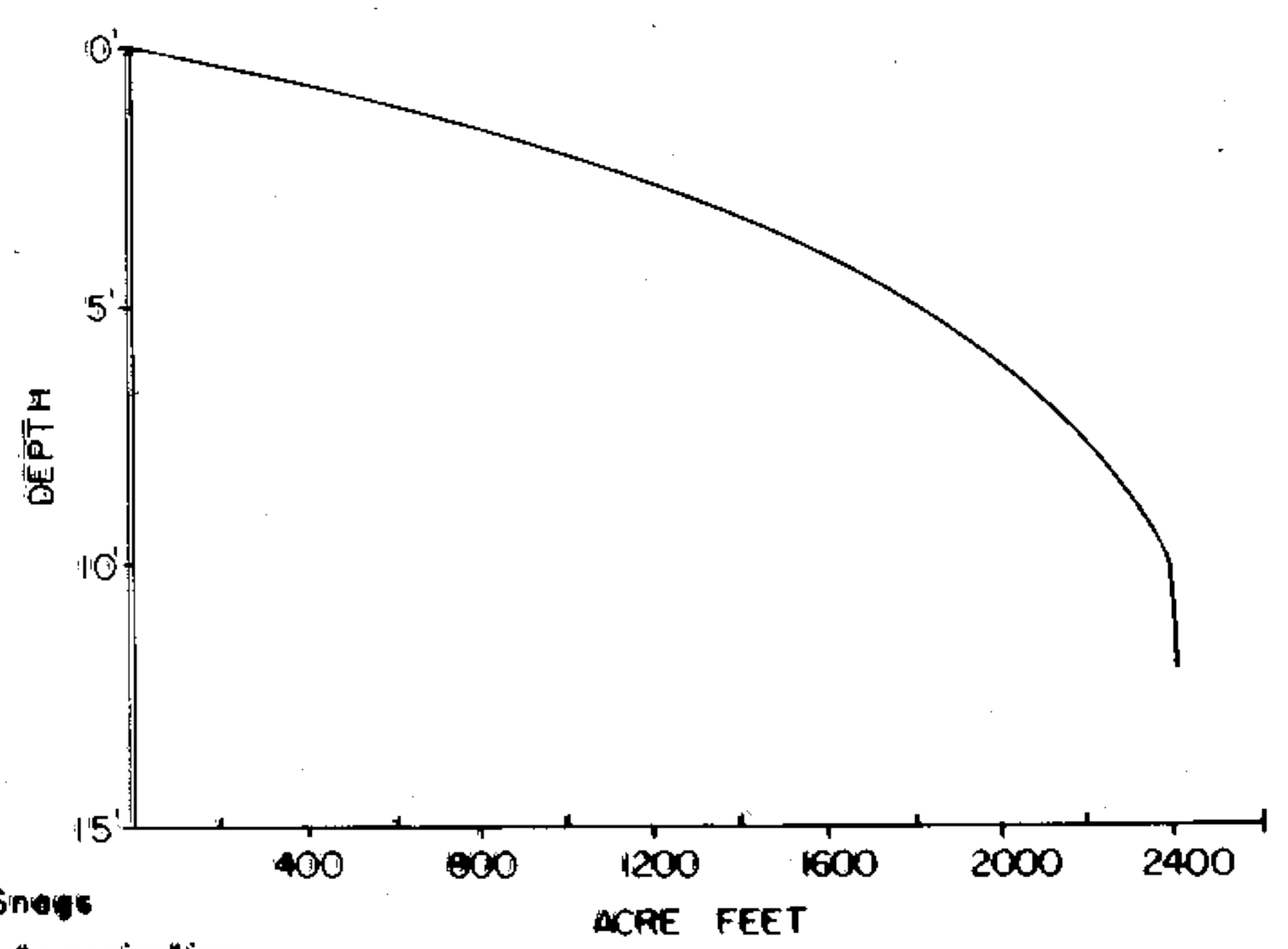


B.M. 'X' Large metal bolt on the NE. side of the center concrete bridge abutment of the LaSalle Ave. bridge
