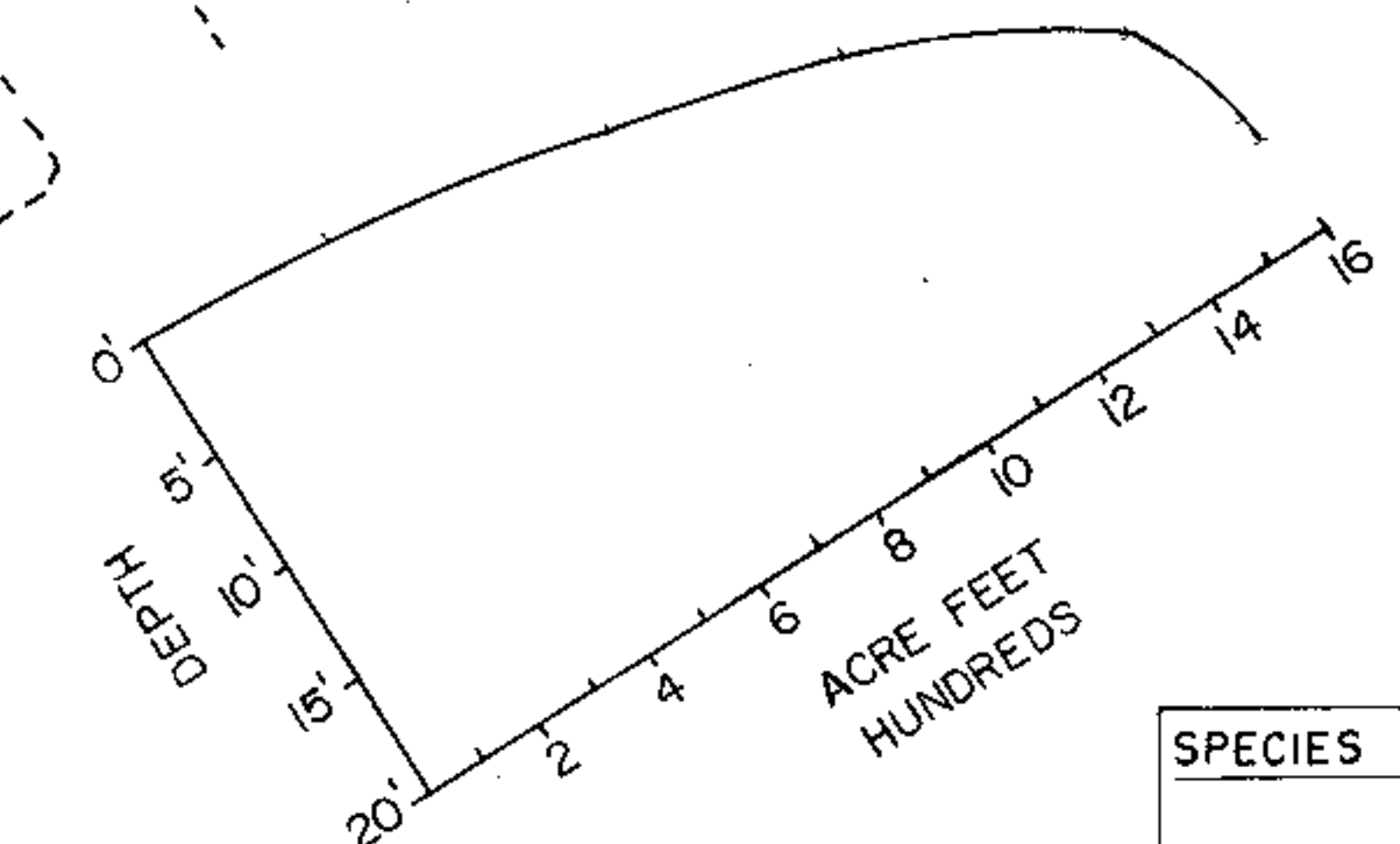


B.M. 'X' P.S.C. in concrete

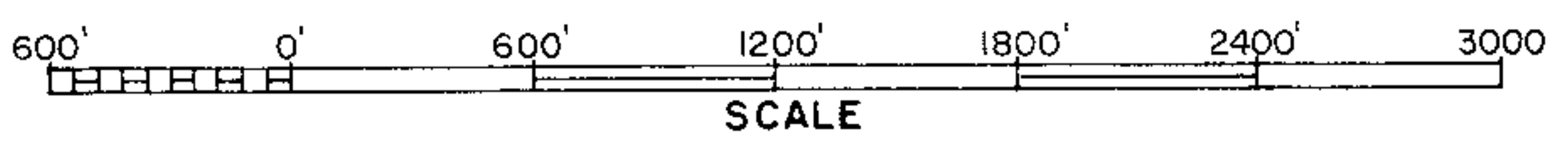
