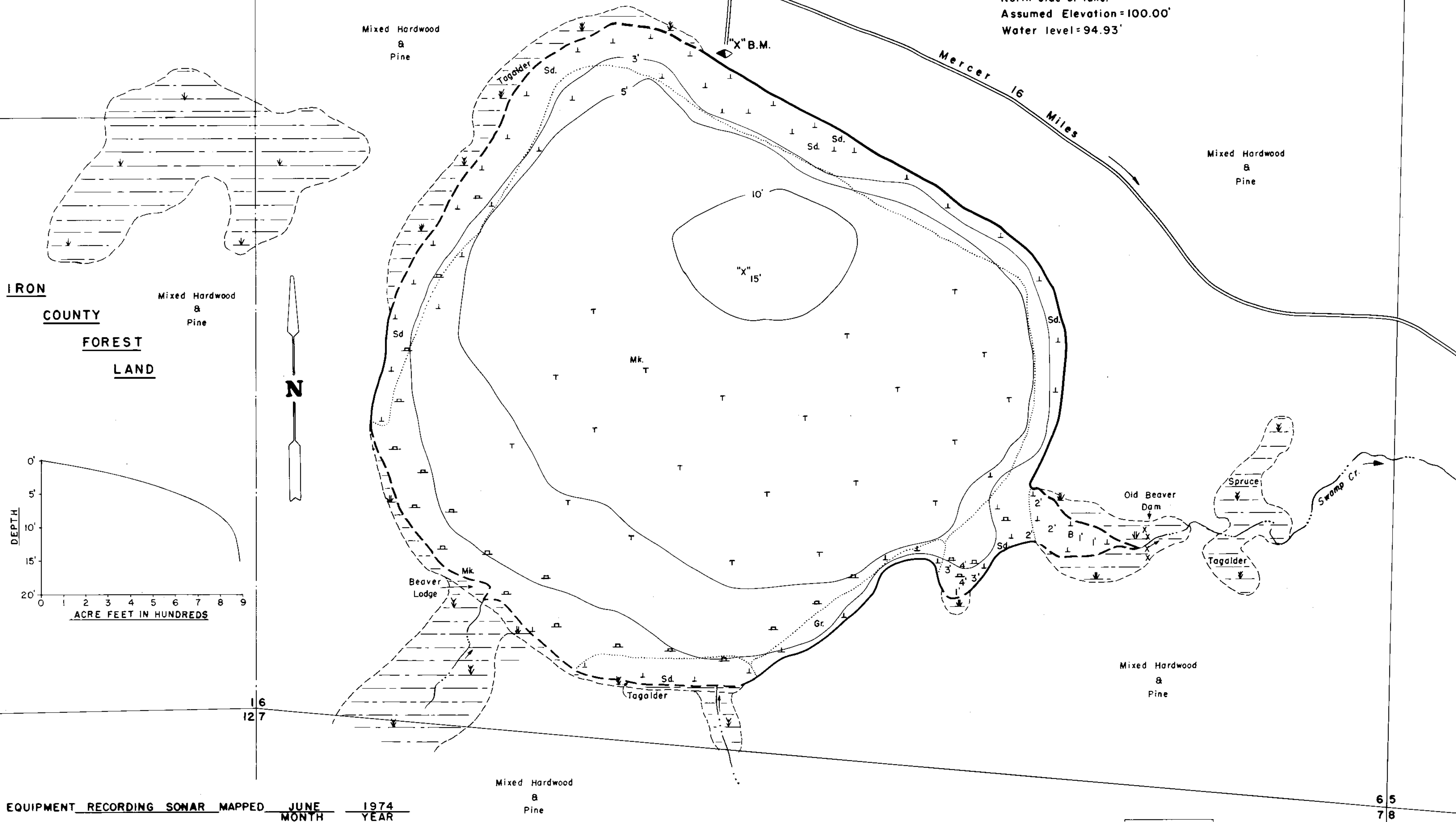
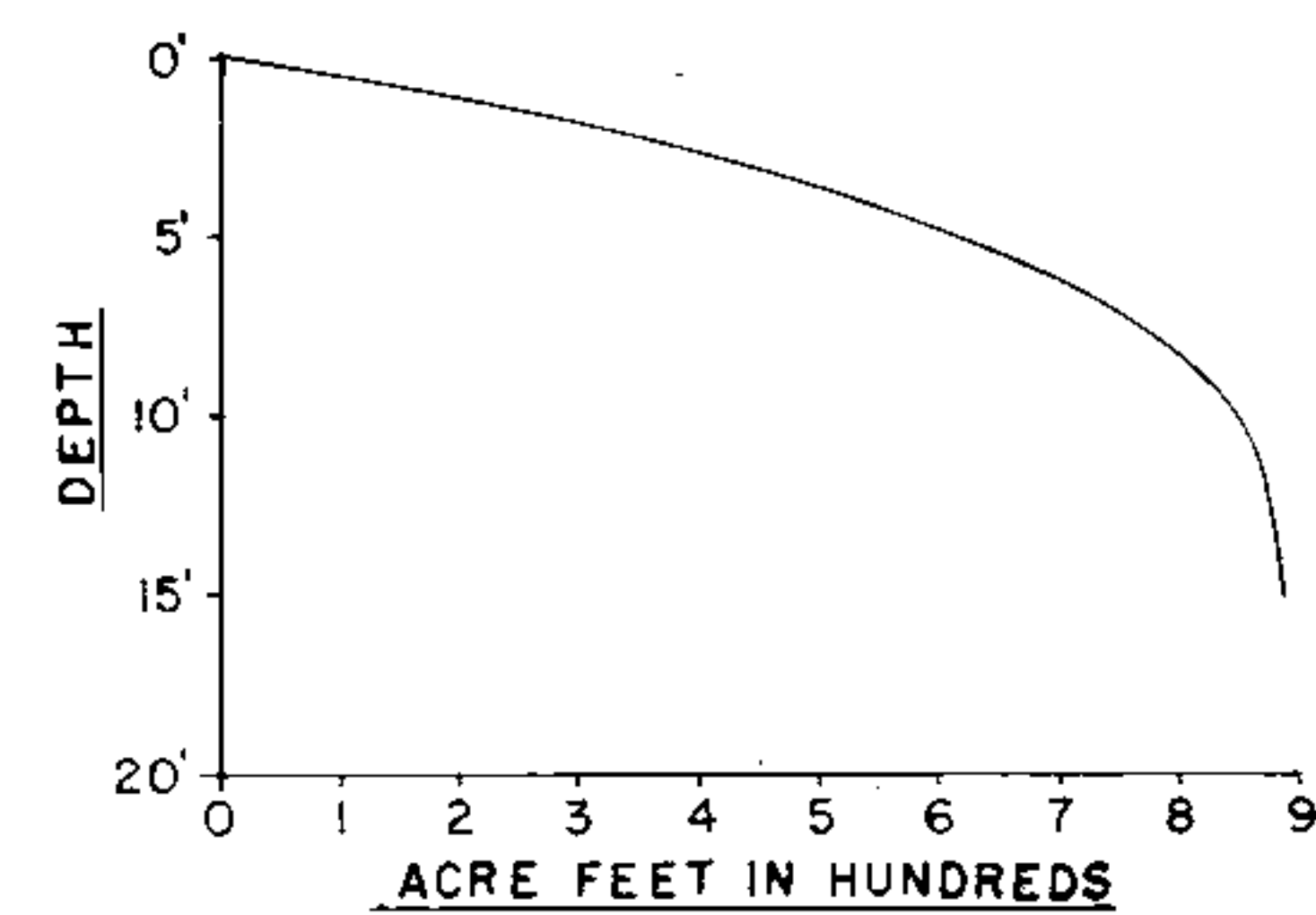


B.M. "X" is a railroad spike in the base of a 24" White Pine, located 9' East of center of access road and 87' North of lake on the North side of lake.
