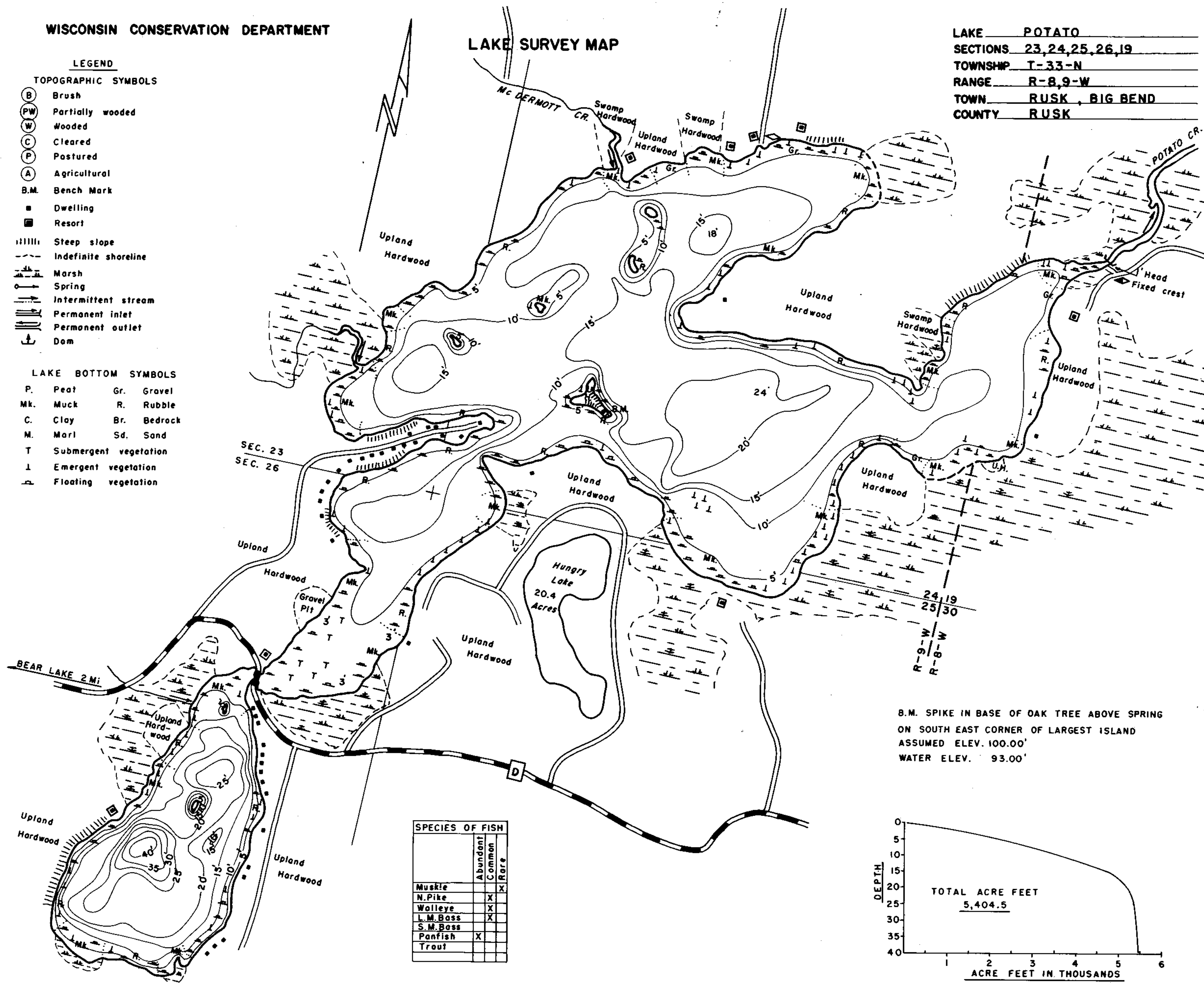

LAKE SURVEY MAP

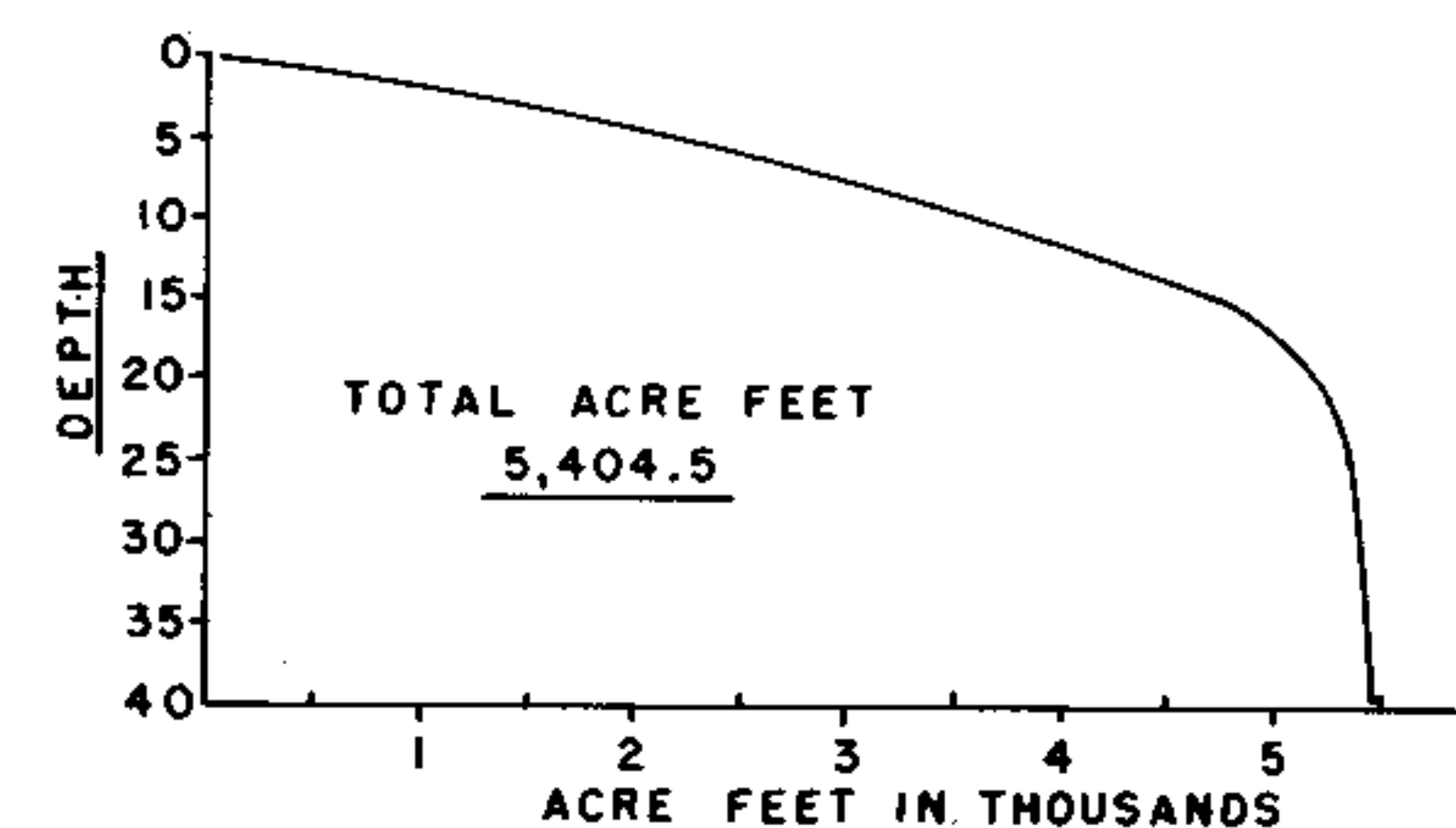

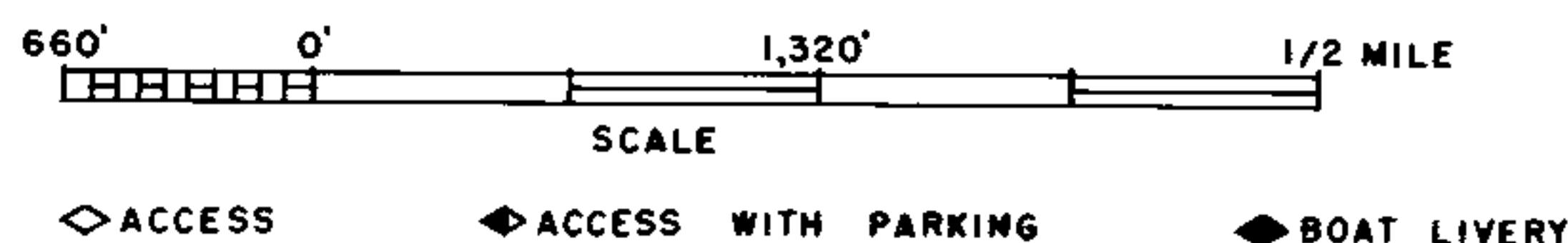


B.M. SPIKE IN BASE OF OAK TREE ABOVE SPRING
