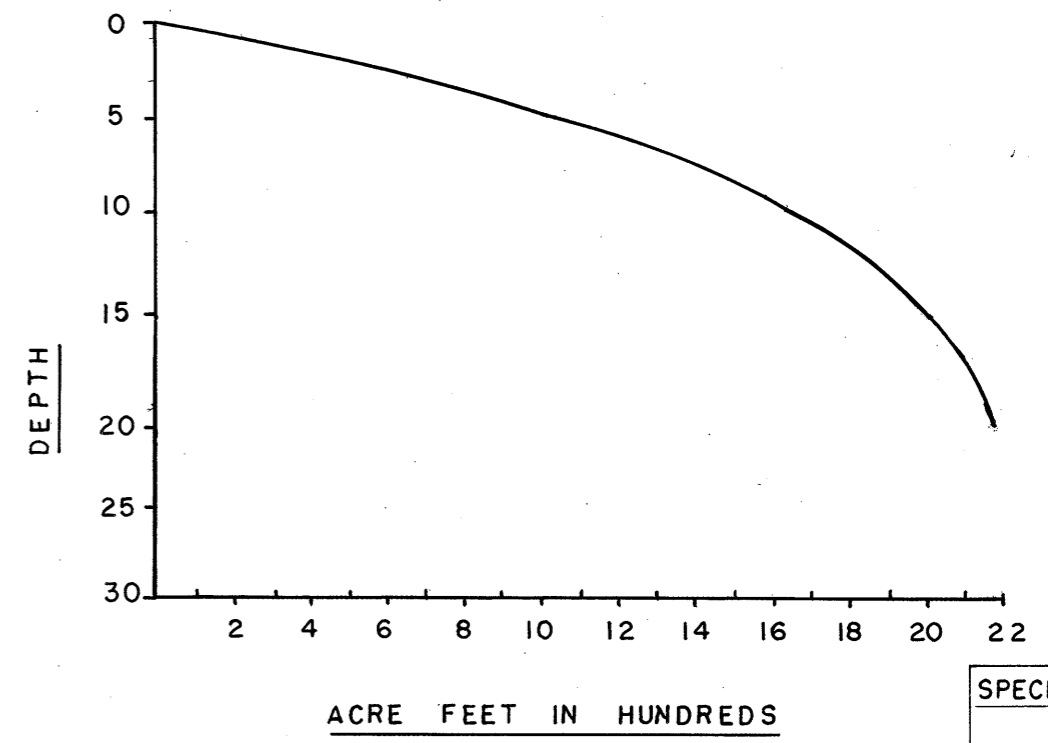


B.M. "X" SPIKE IN WHITE PINE ON POINT

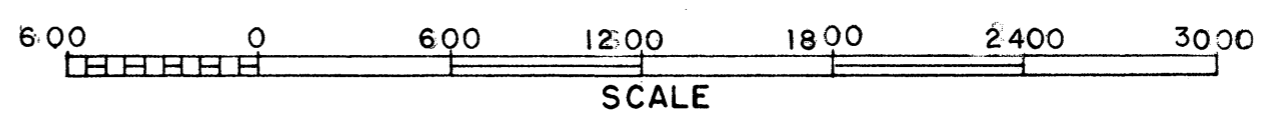
