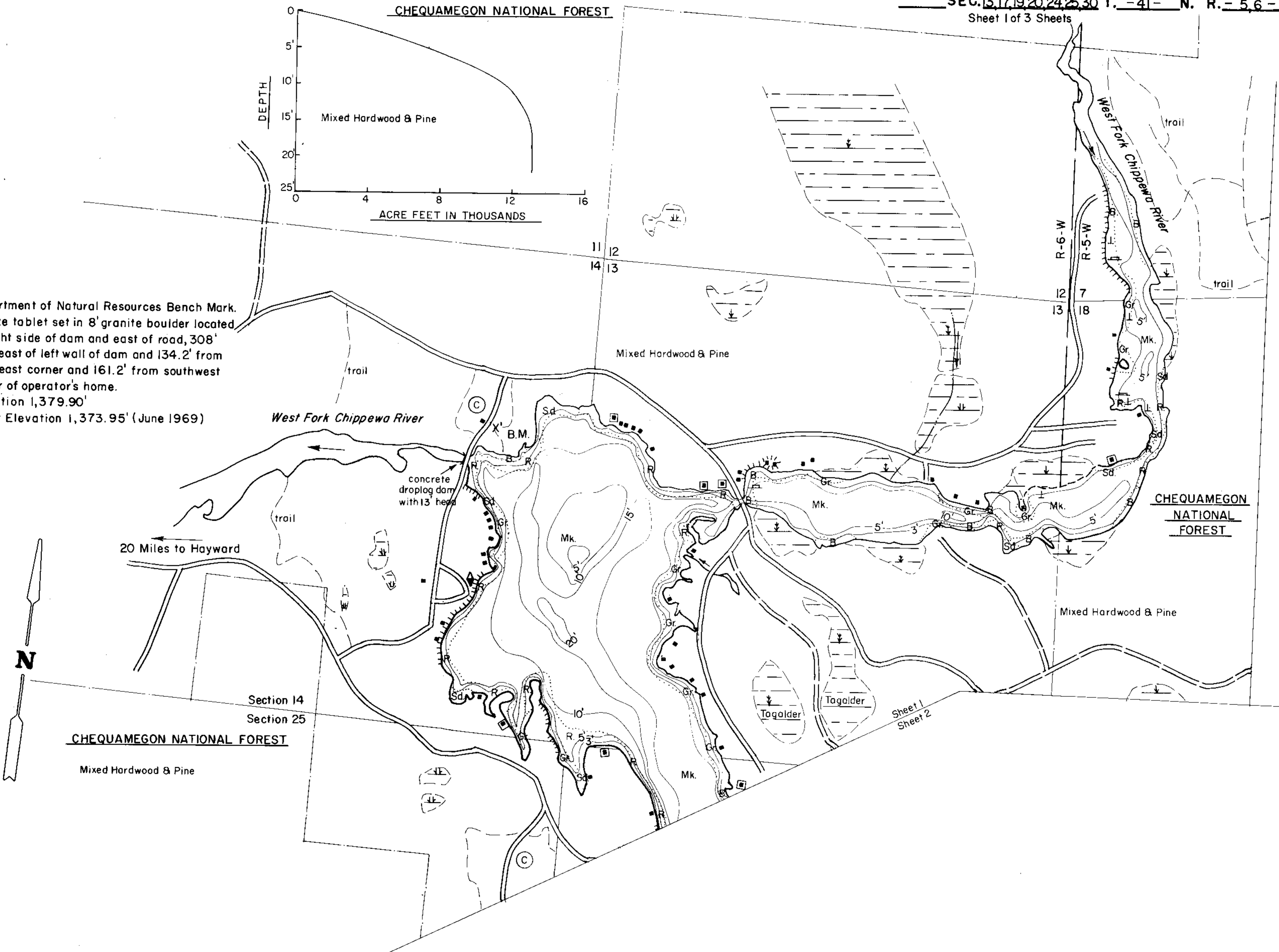


Department of Natural Resources Bench Mark.

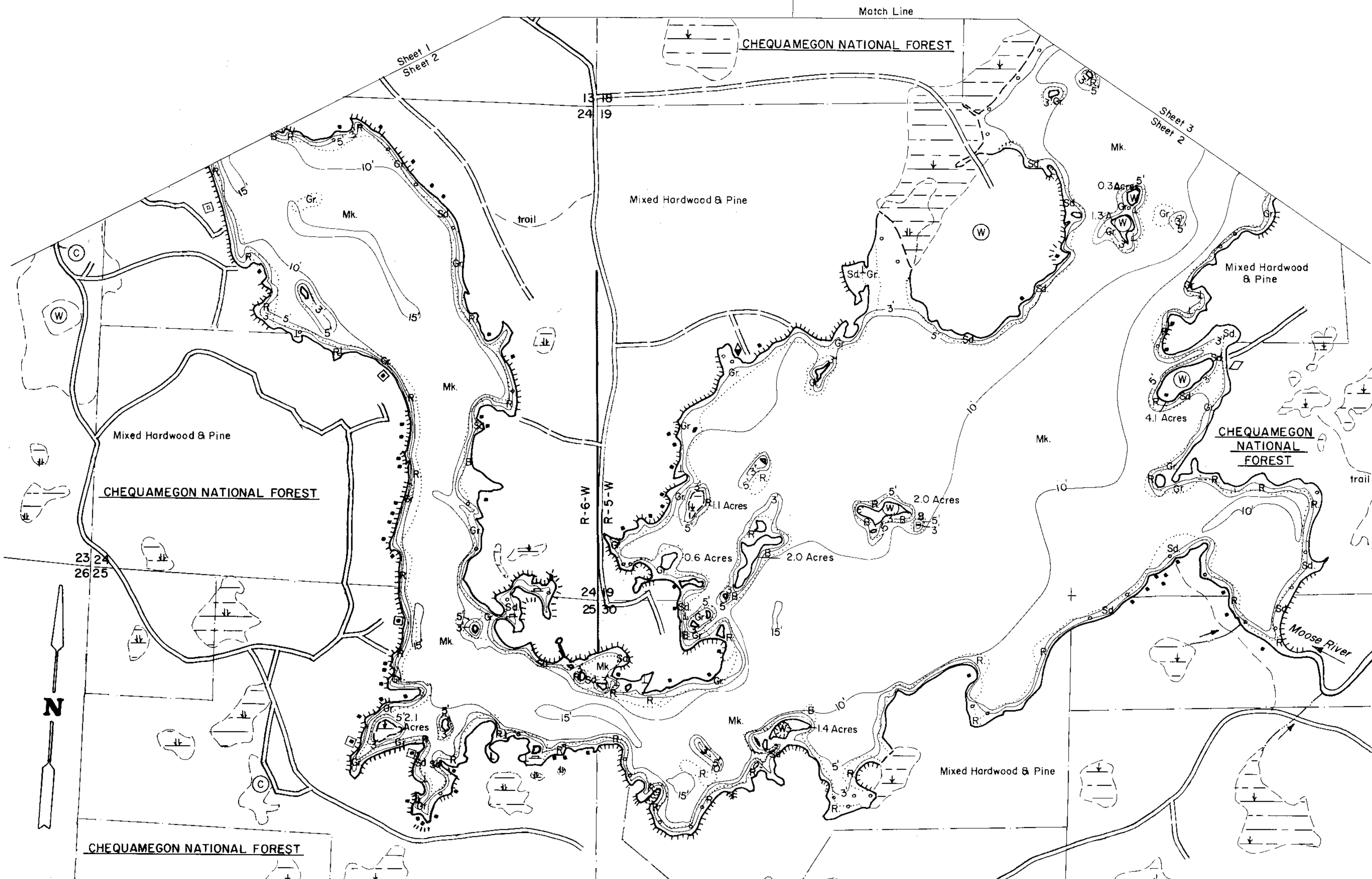

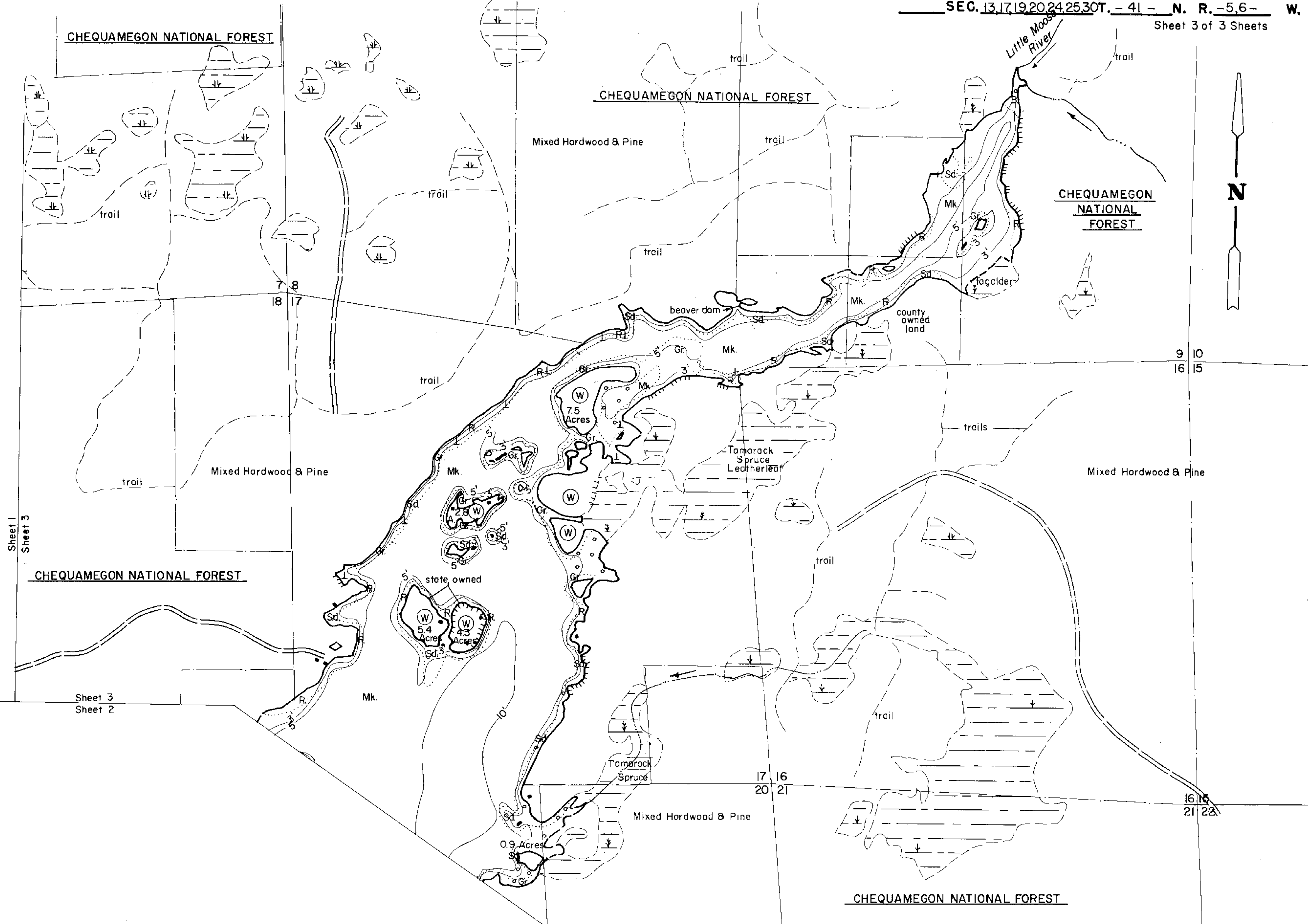
