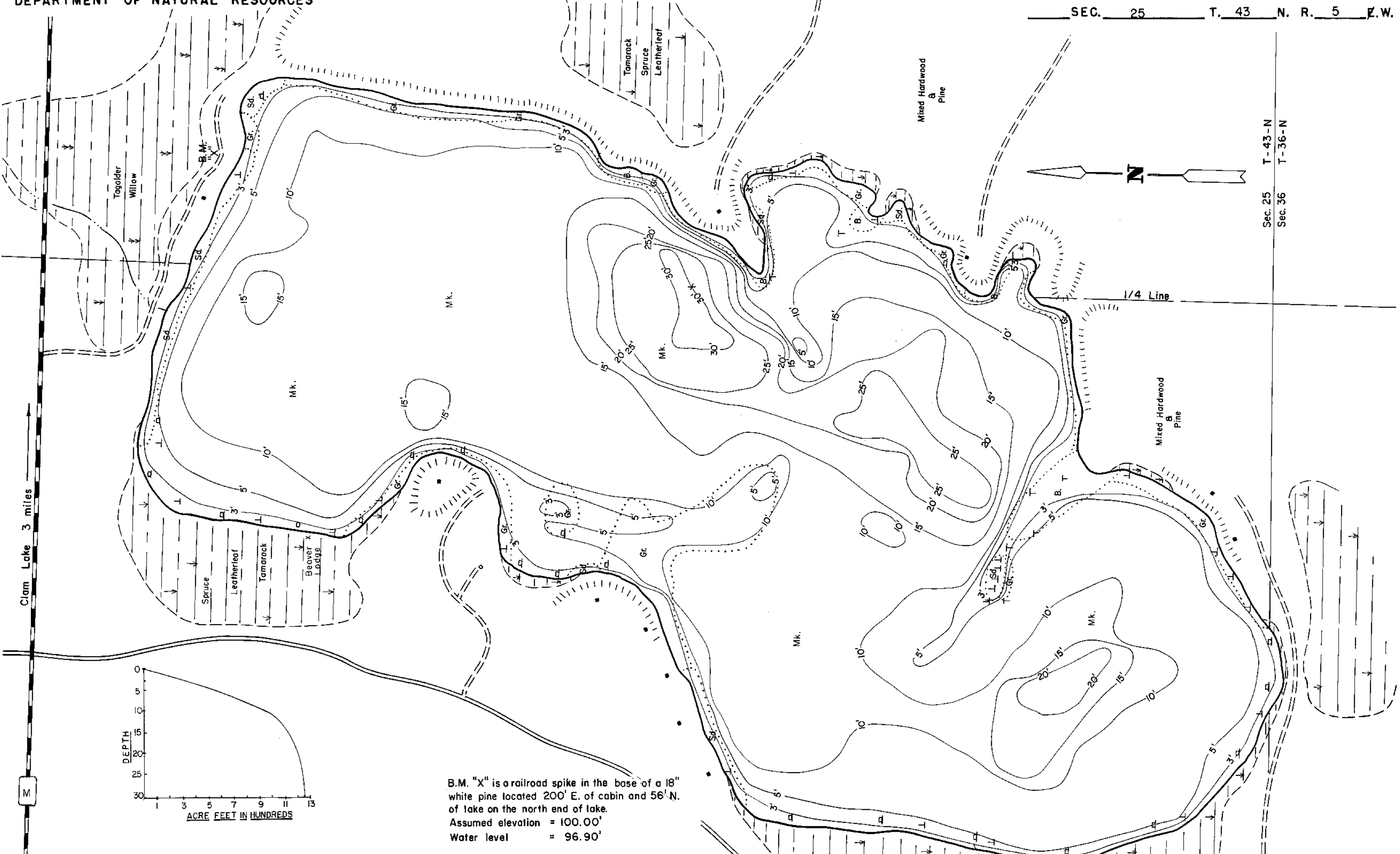
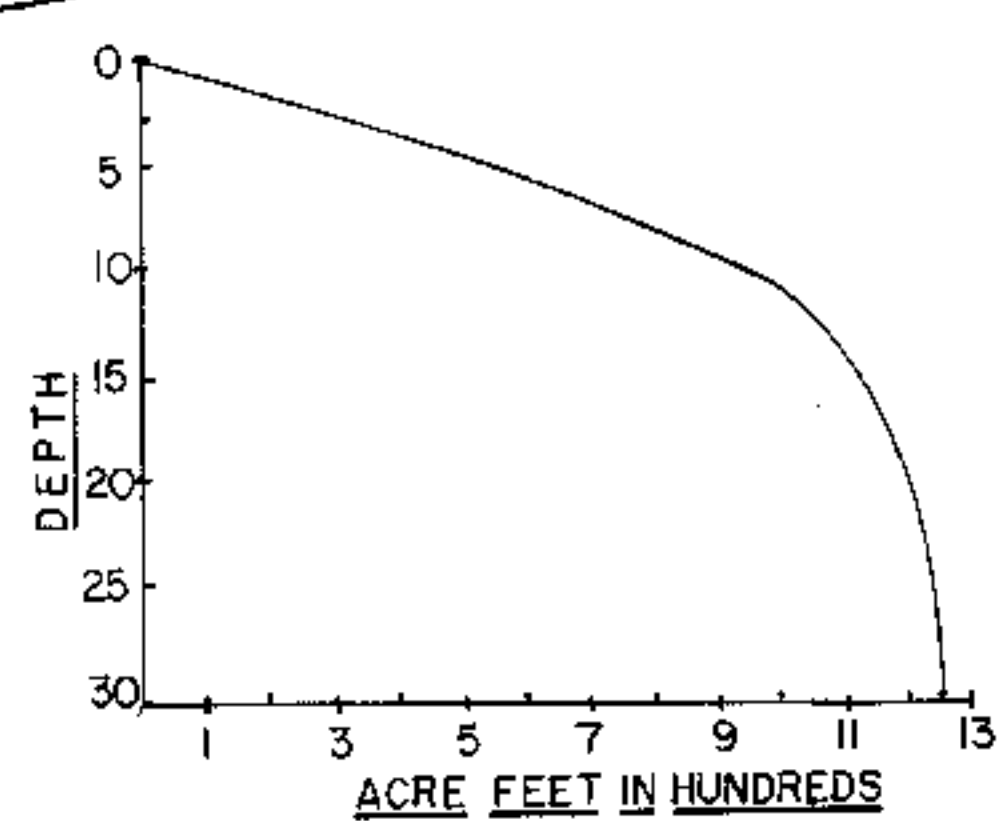


LAKE SURVEY MAP

SEC. 25 T. 43 N. R. 5 E.W.



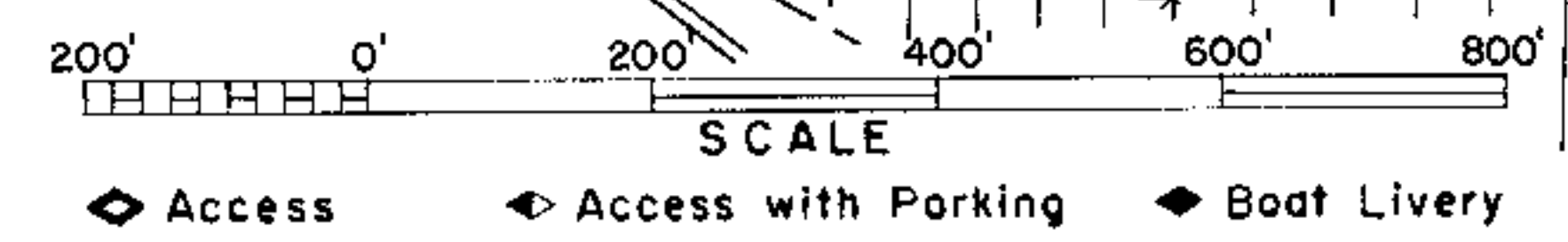
Clam Lake 3 miles
