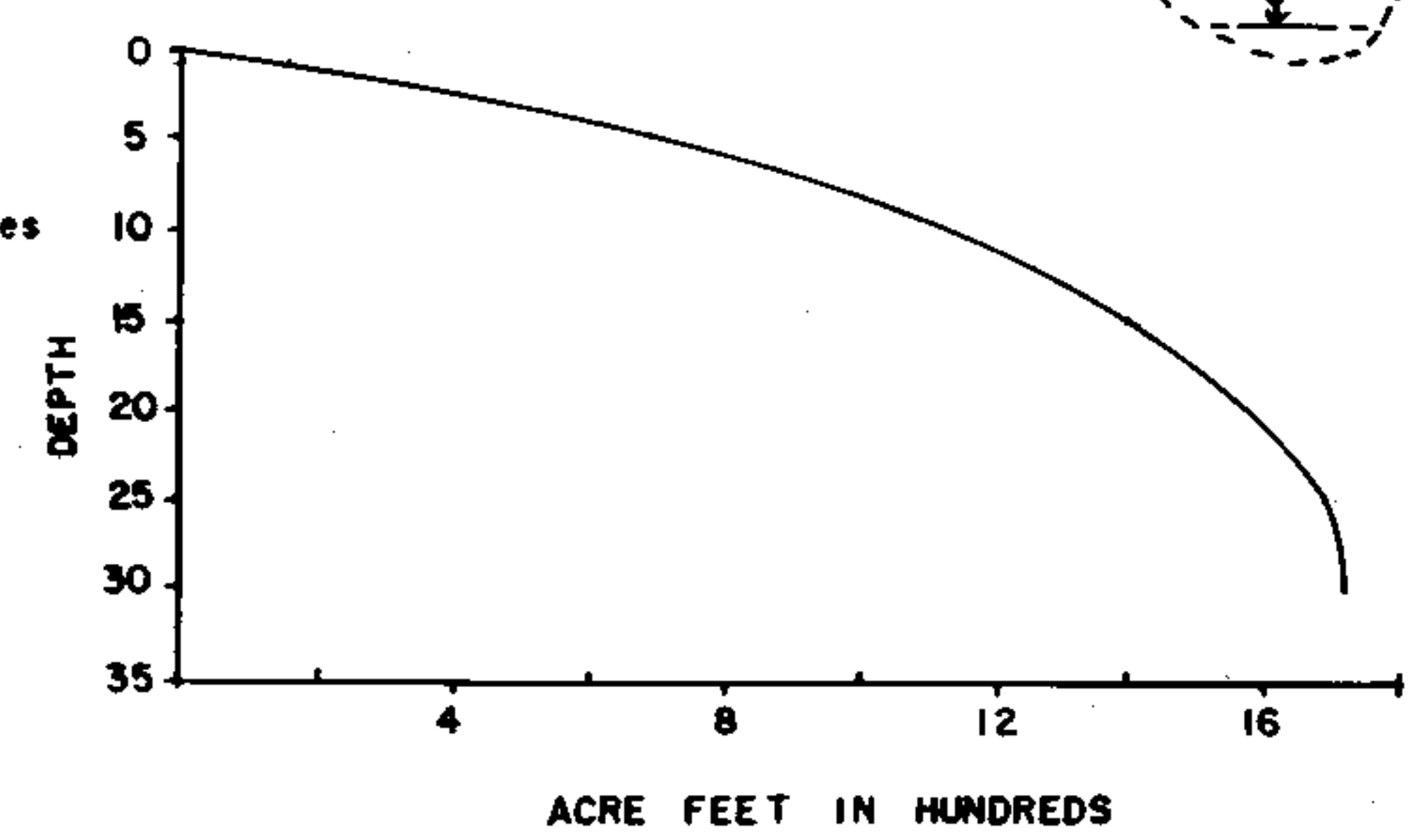


B.M. "X" TOP OF CULVERT ON WEST

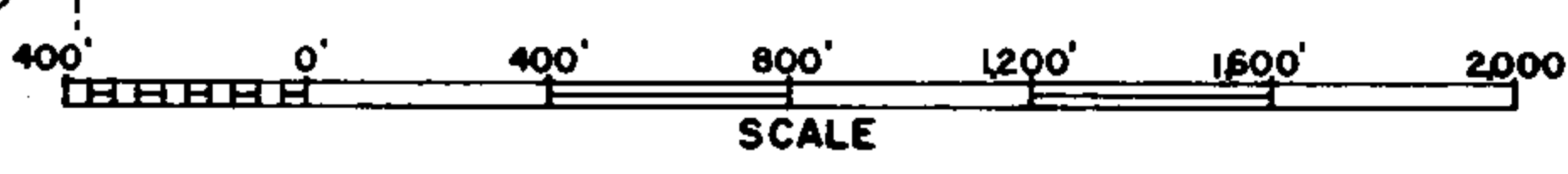
