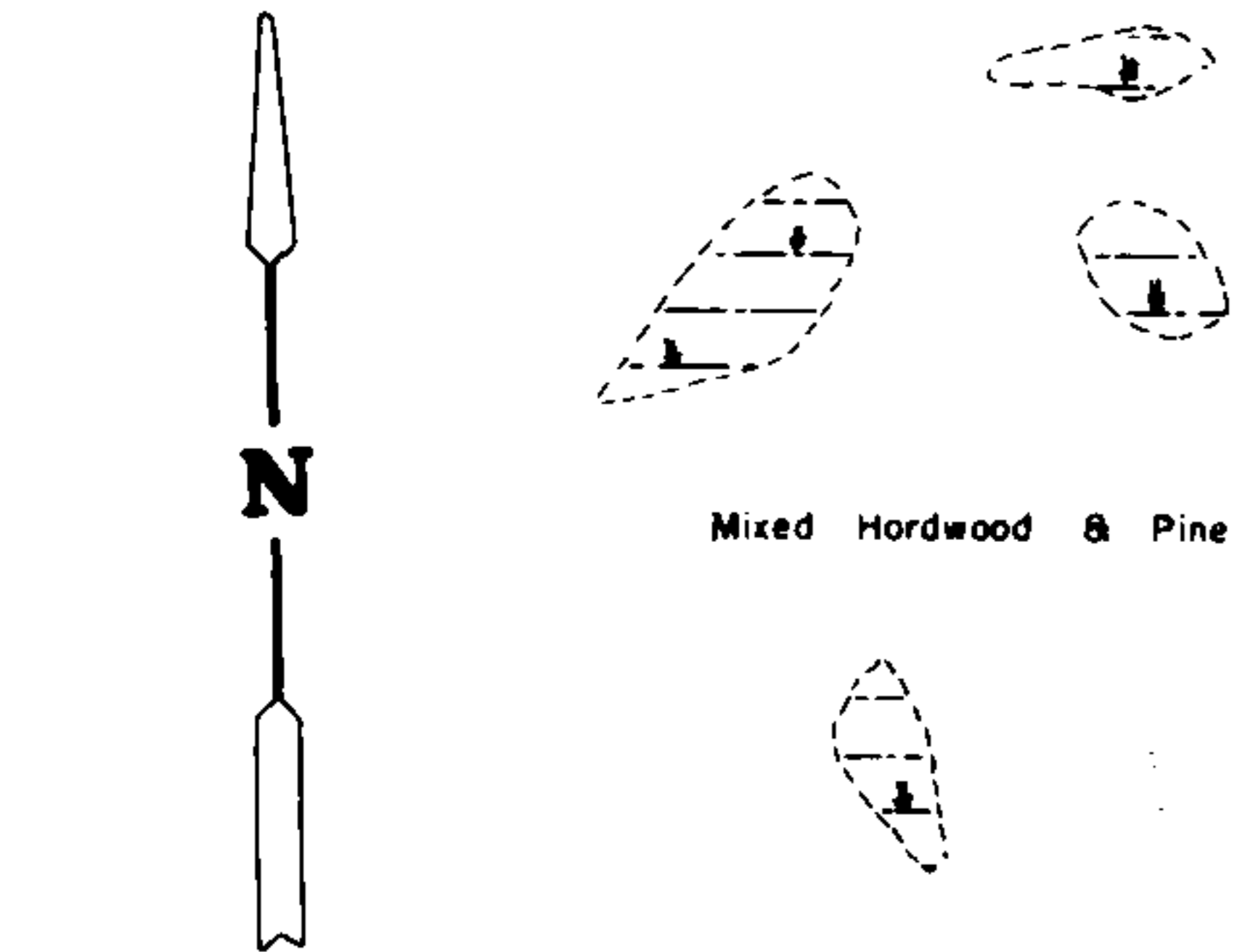
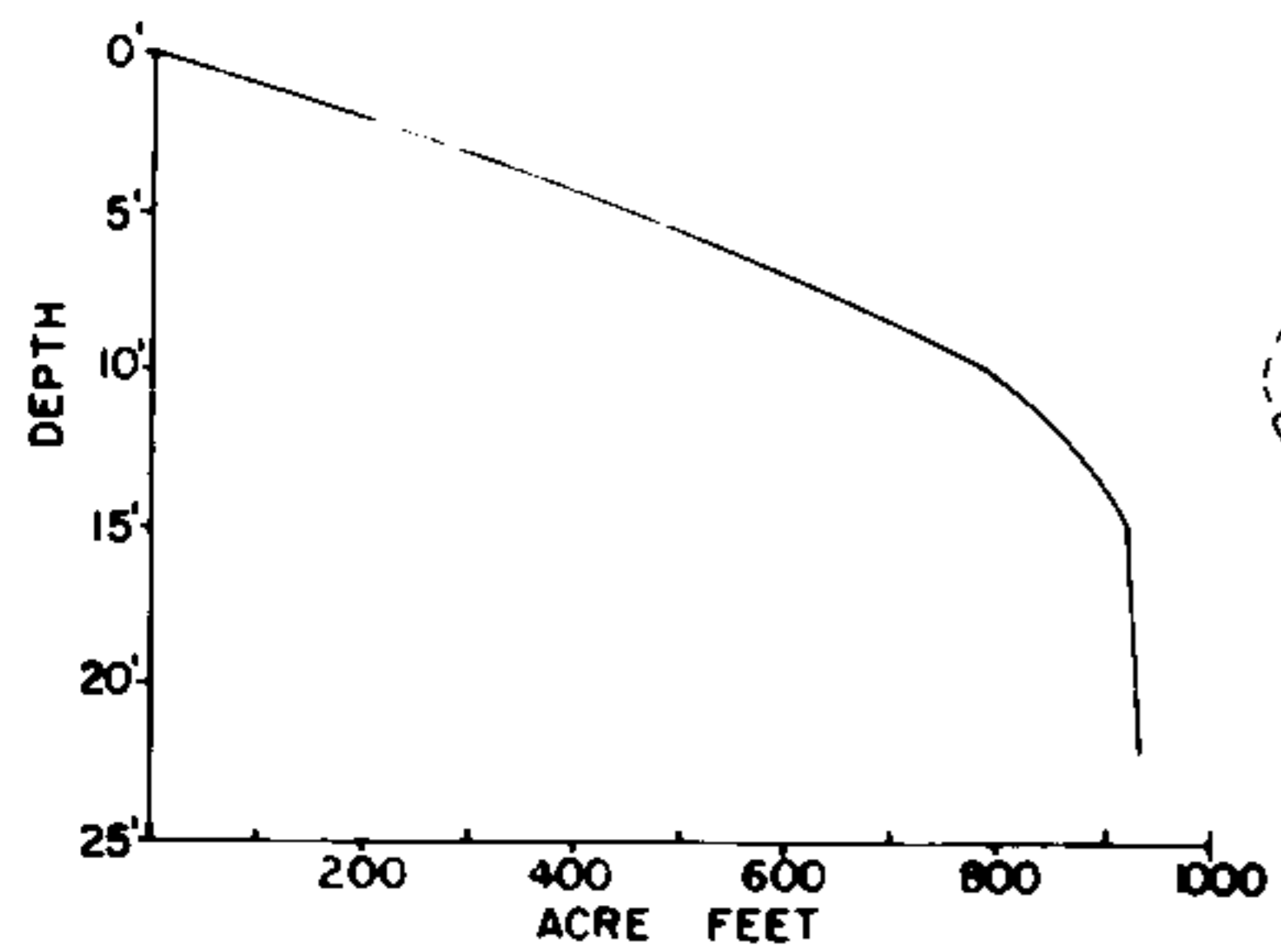
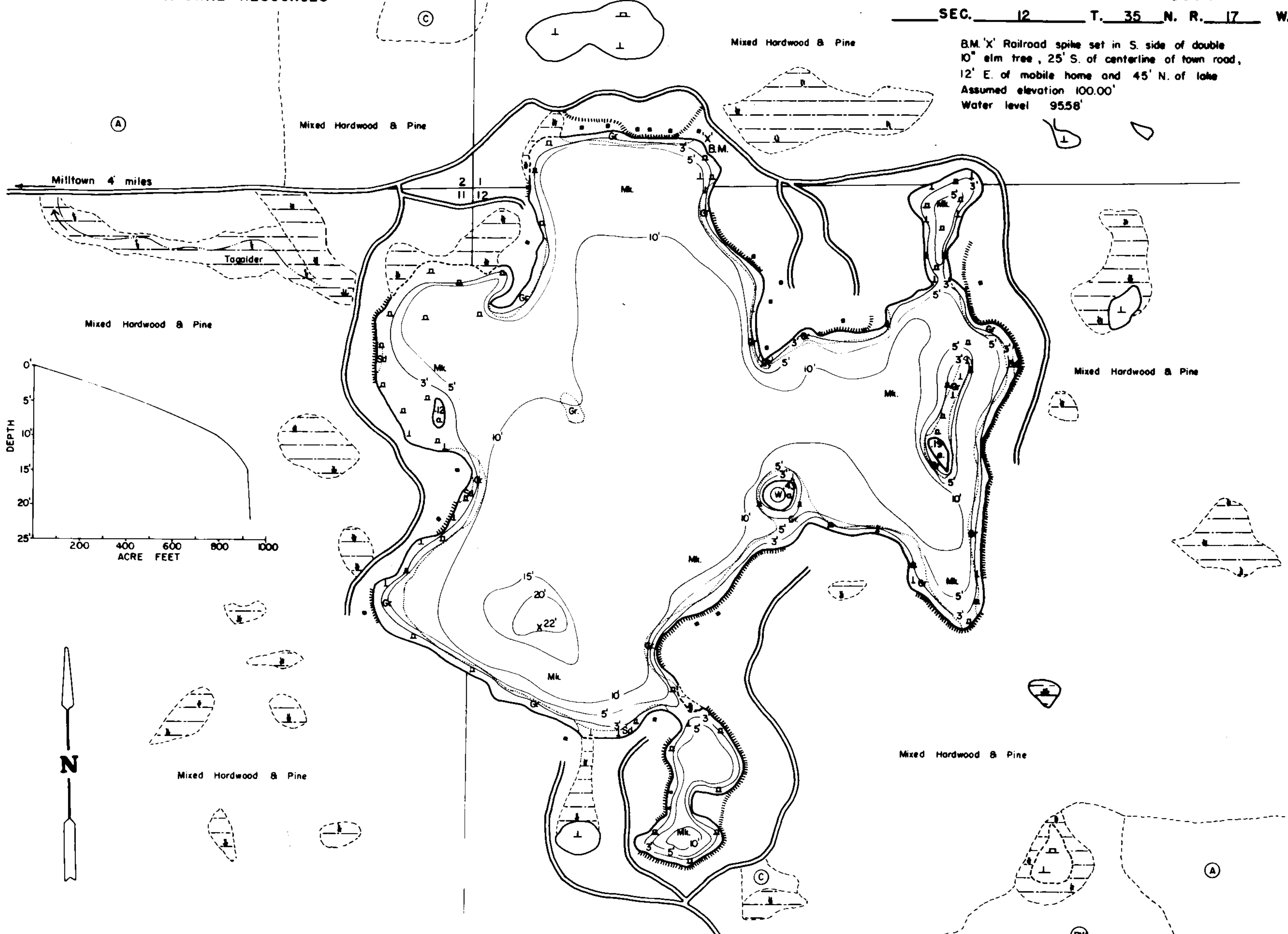


B.M. 'X' Railroad spike set in S. side of double
