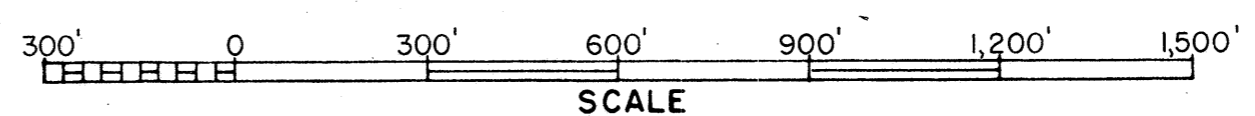


D.N.R. B.M. 1098-A. Bronze tablet east of highline pole at public access. Assumed elevation 100.00' Water elevation 95.32'
