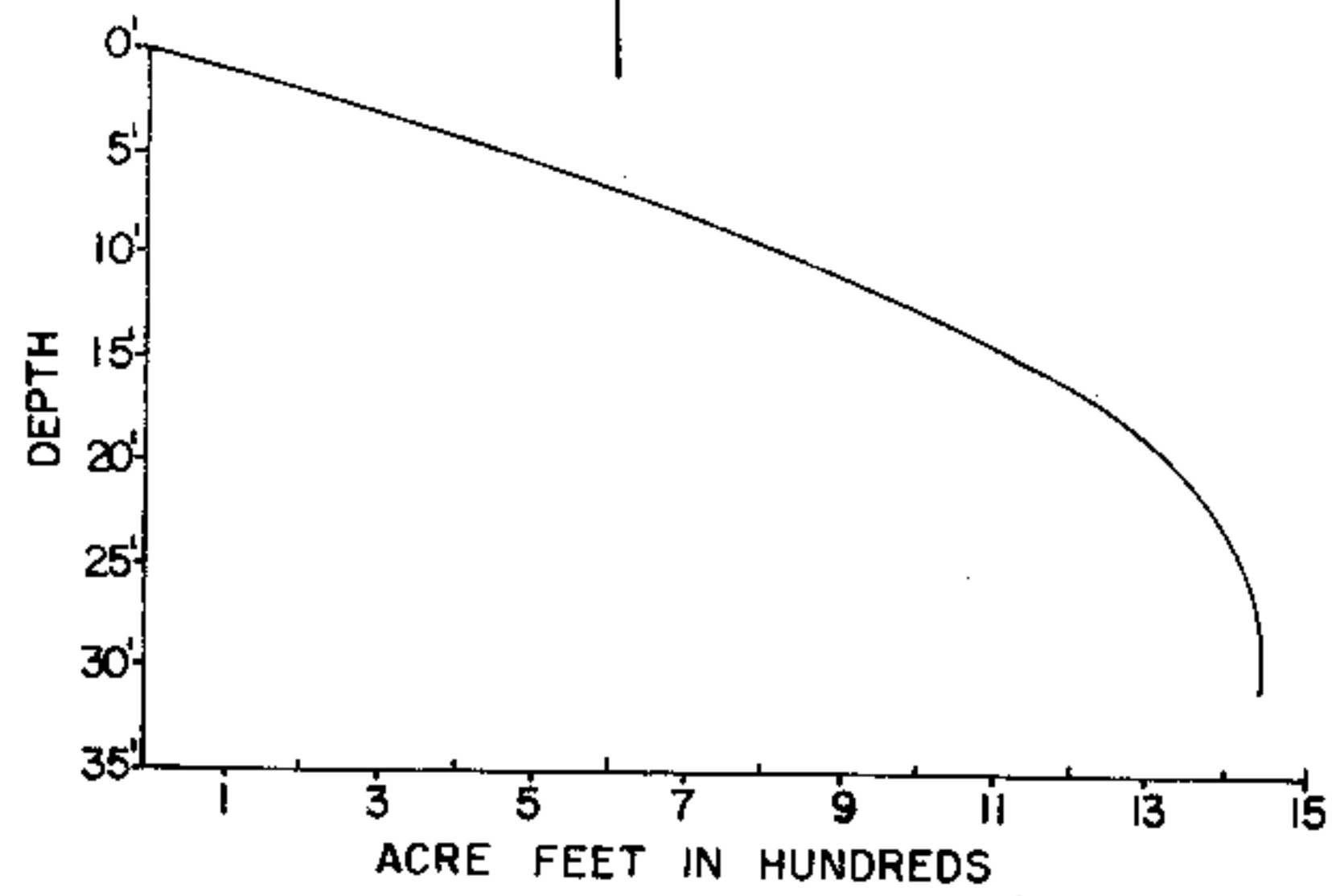


LAKE SURVEY MAP

SEC. 12, 13 T. 43 N. R. 12 W.

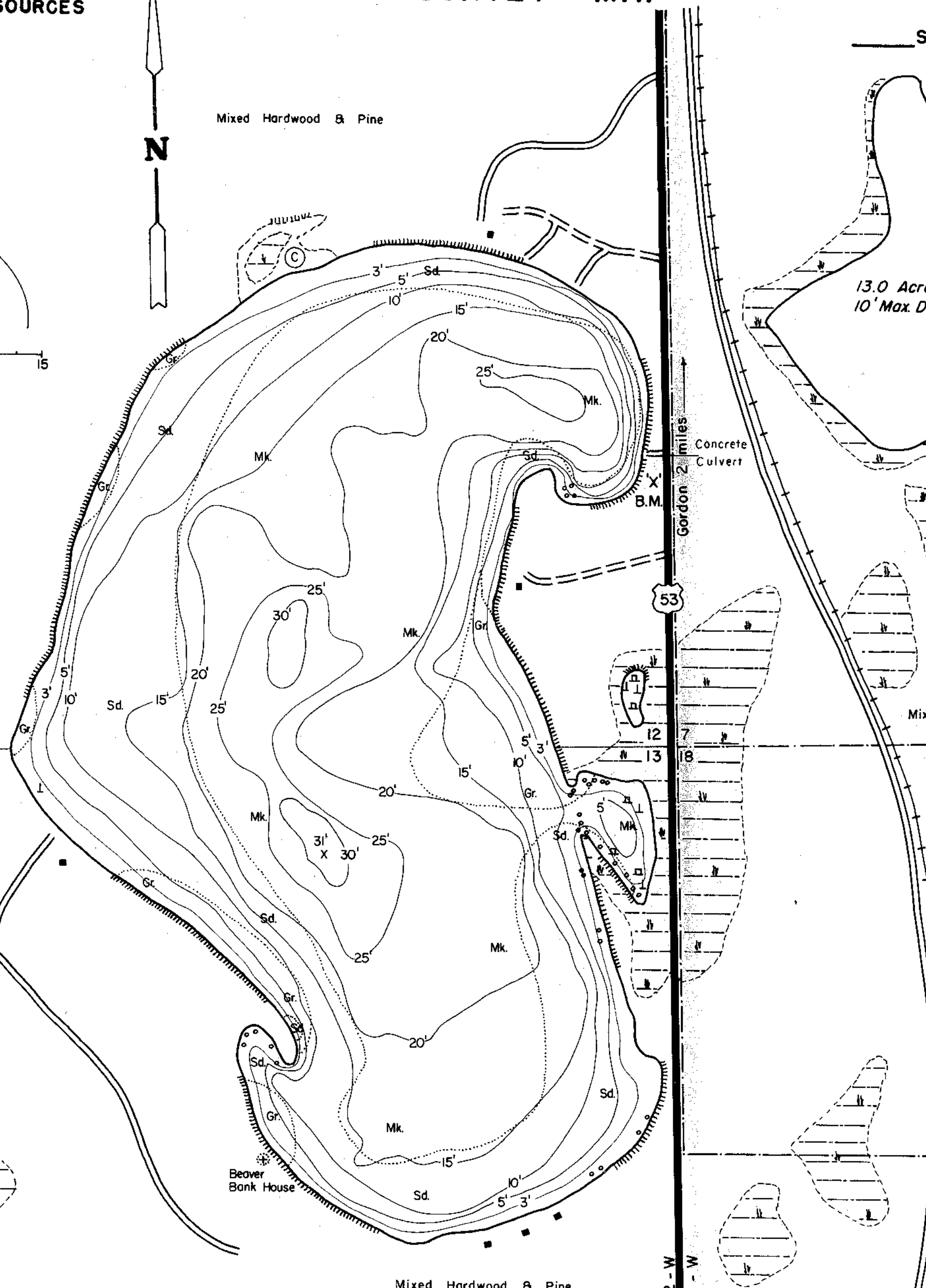

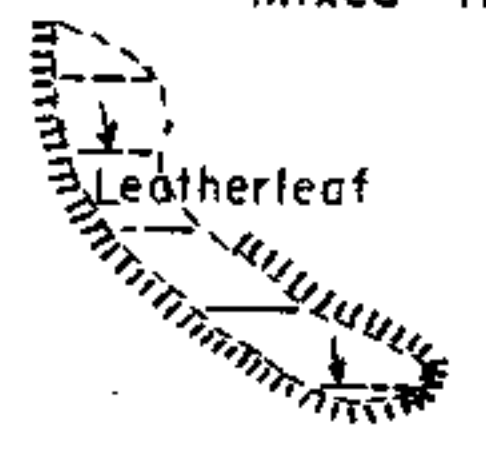
