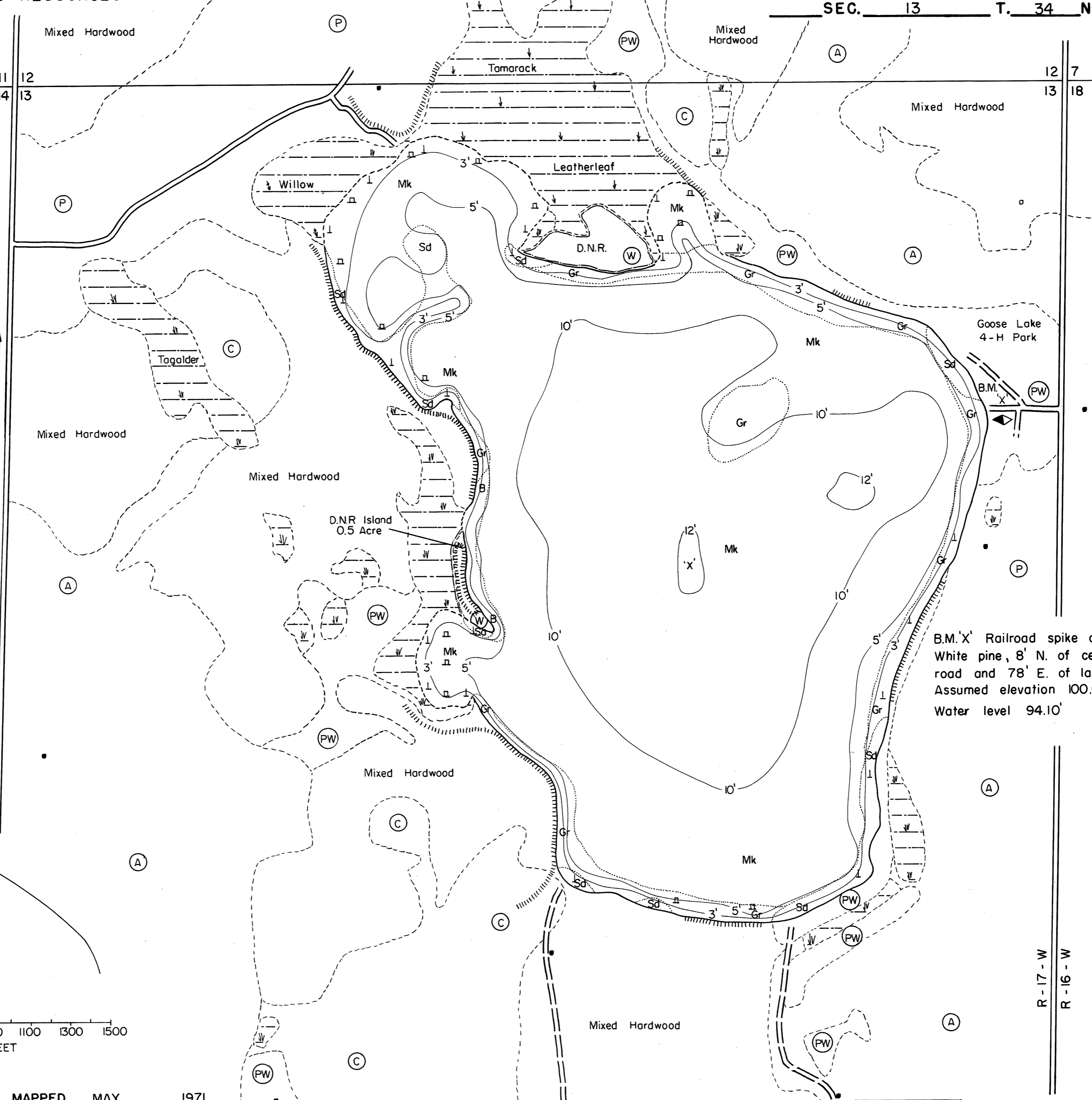
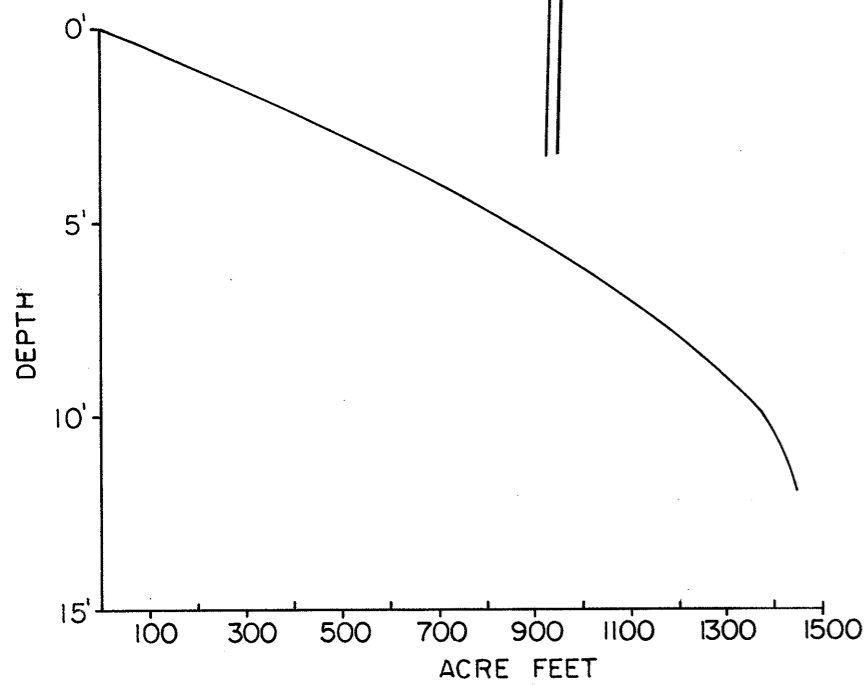


LAKE SURVEY MAP

Water level 94.10'

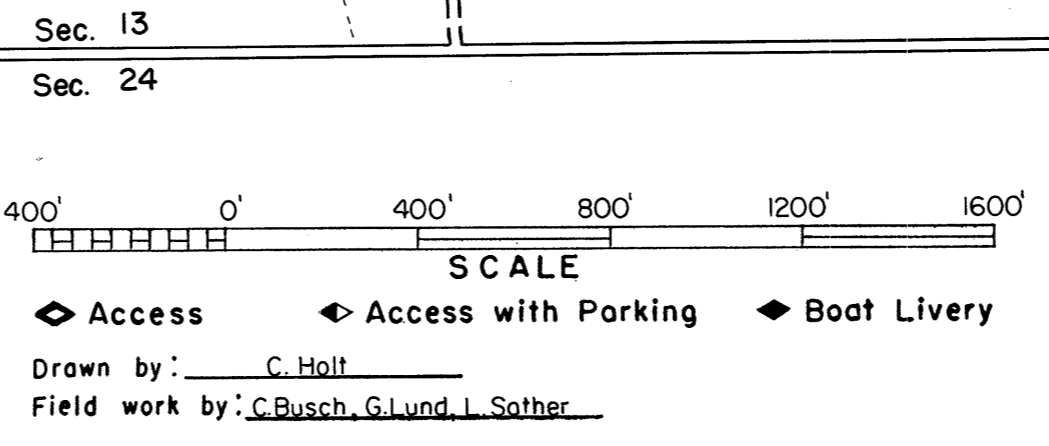
