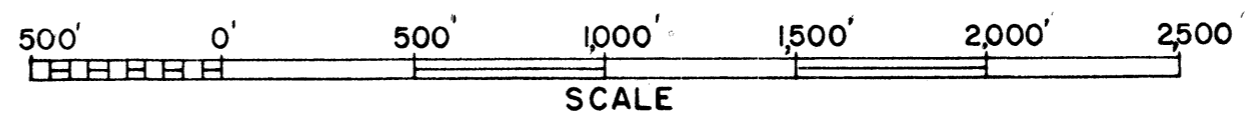


B.M. Spike in large White Pine on S.E. side of lake 60' from shore. Assumed Elev. 100.00 Water Elev. 94.00
