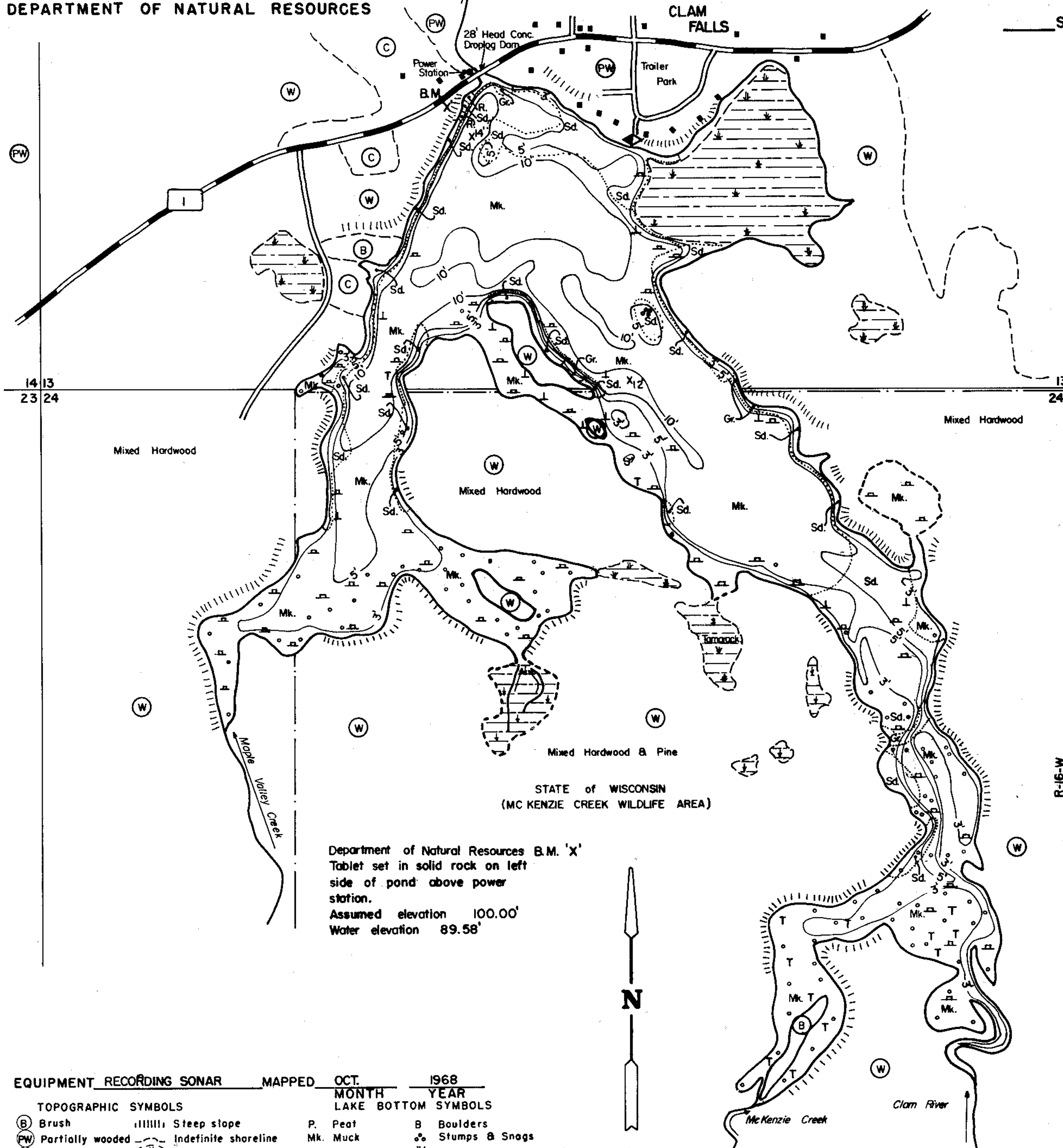


# LAKE SURVEY MAP

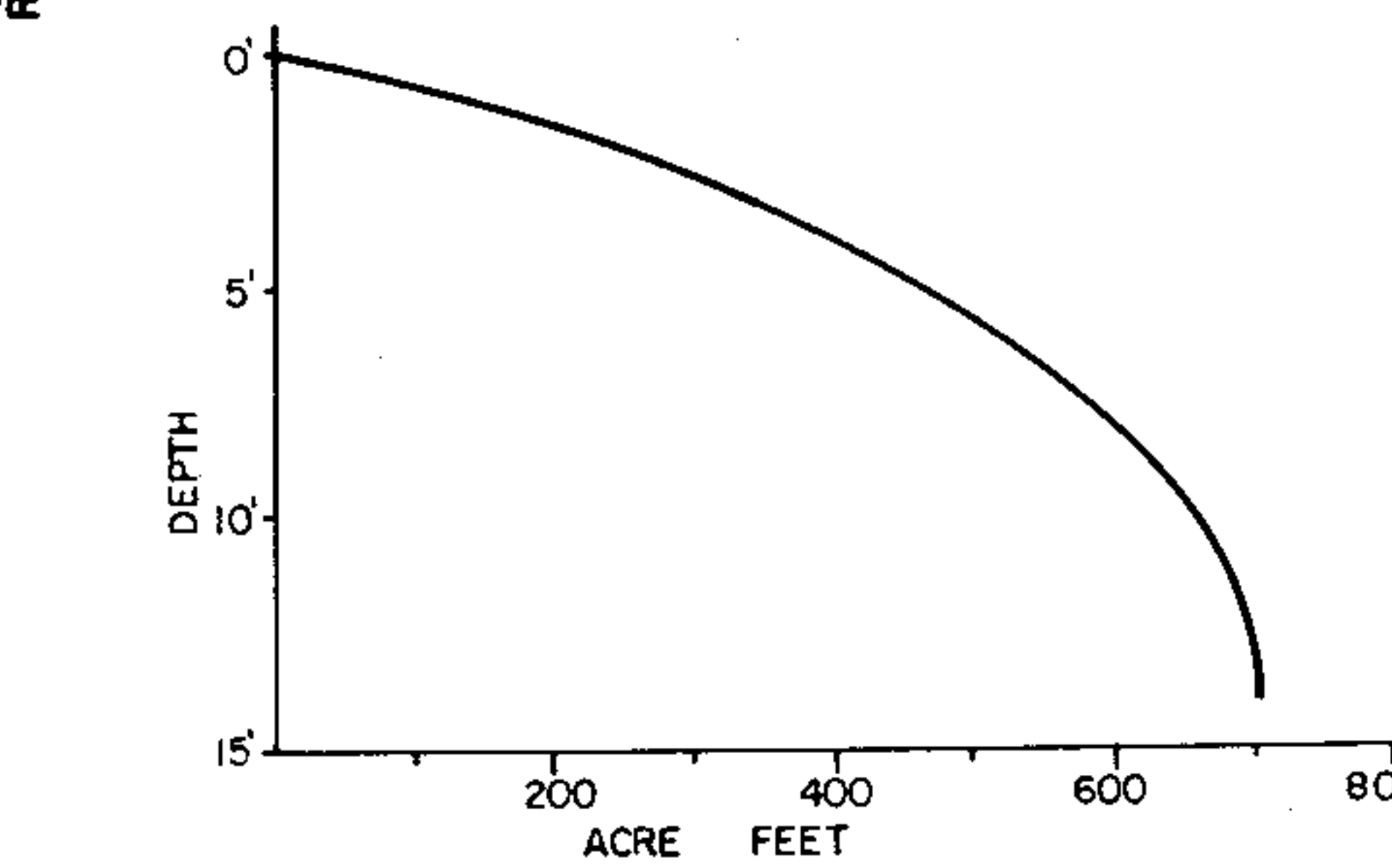
