LAKE SURVEY MAP

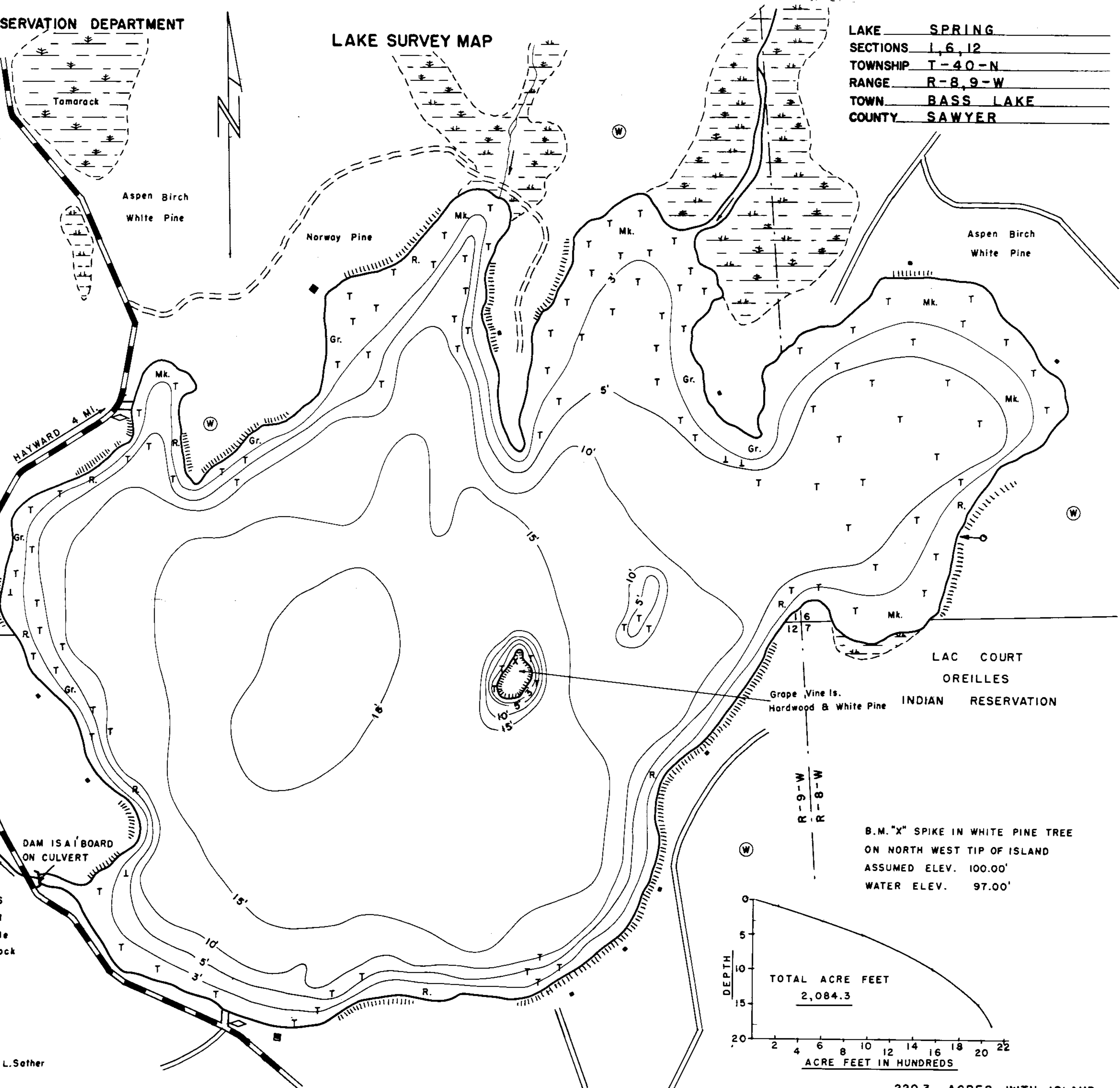

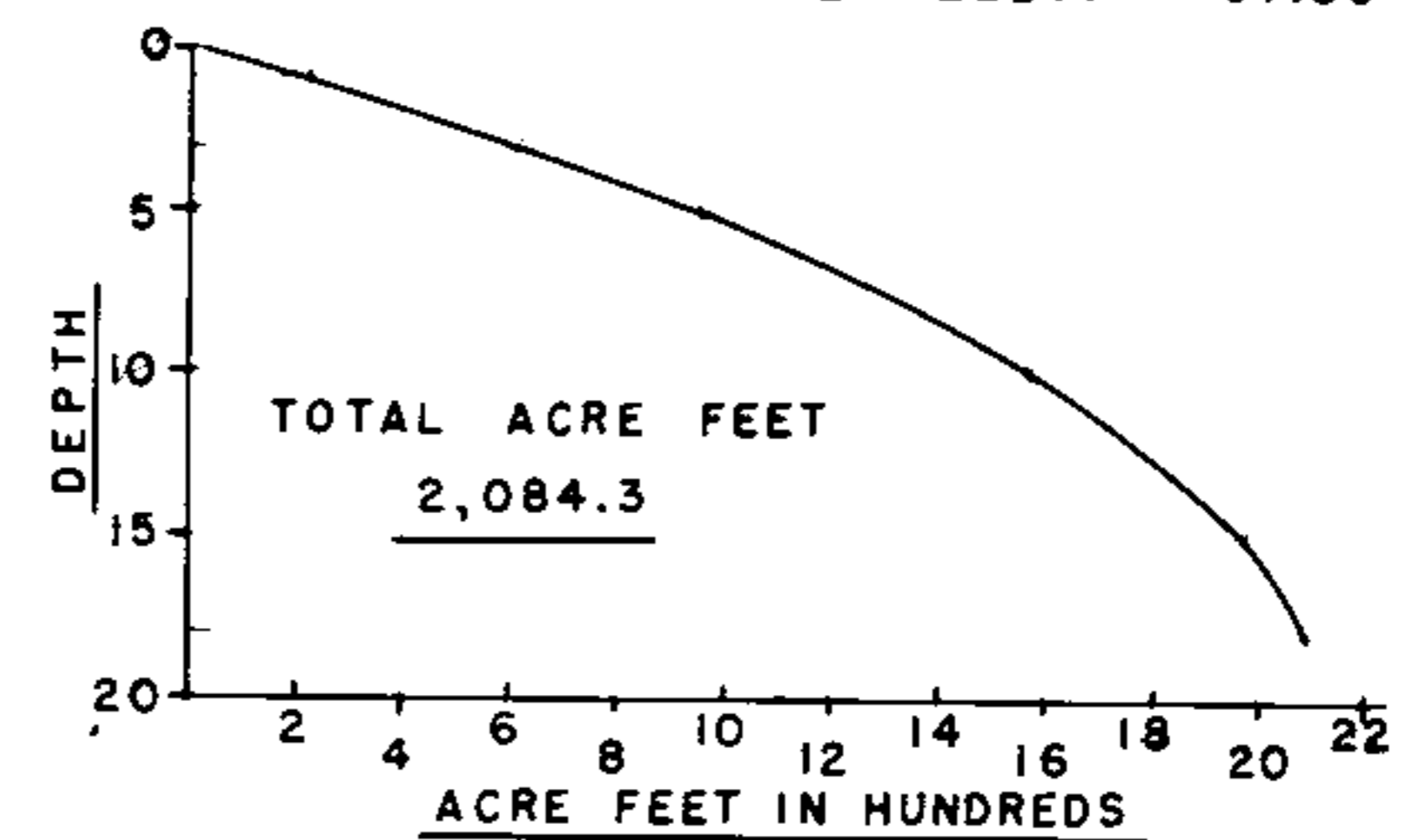
