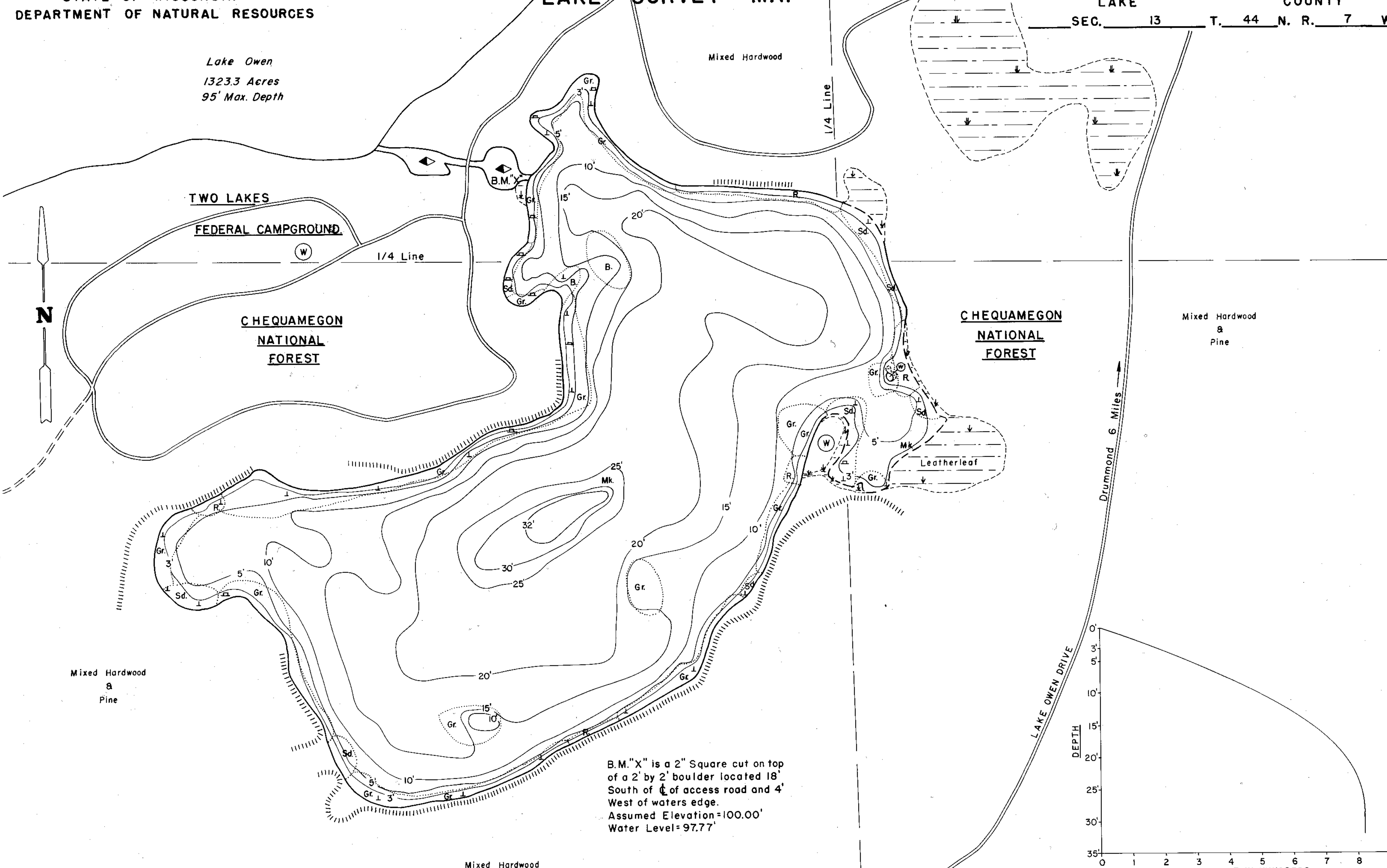


Lake Owen
