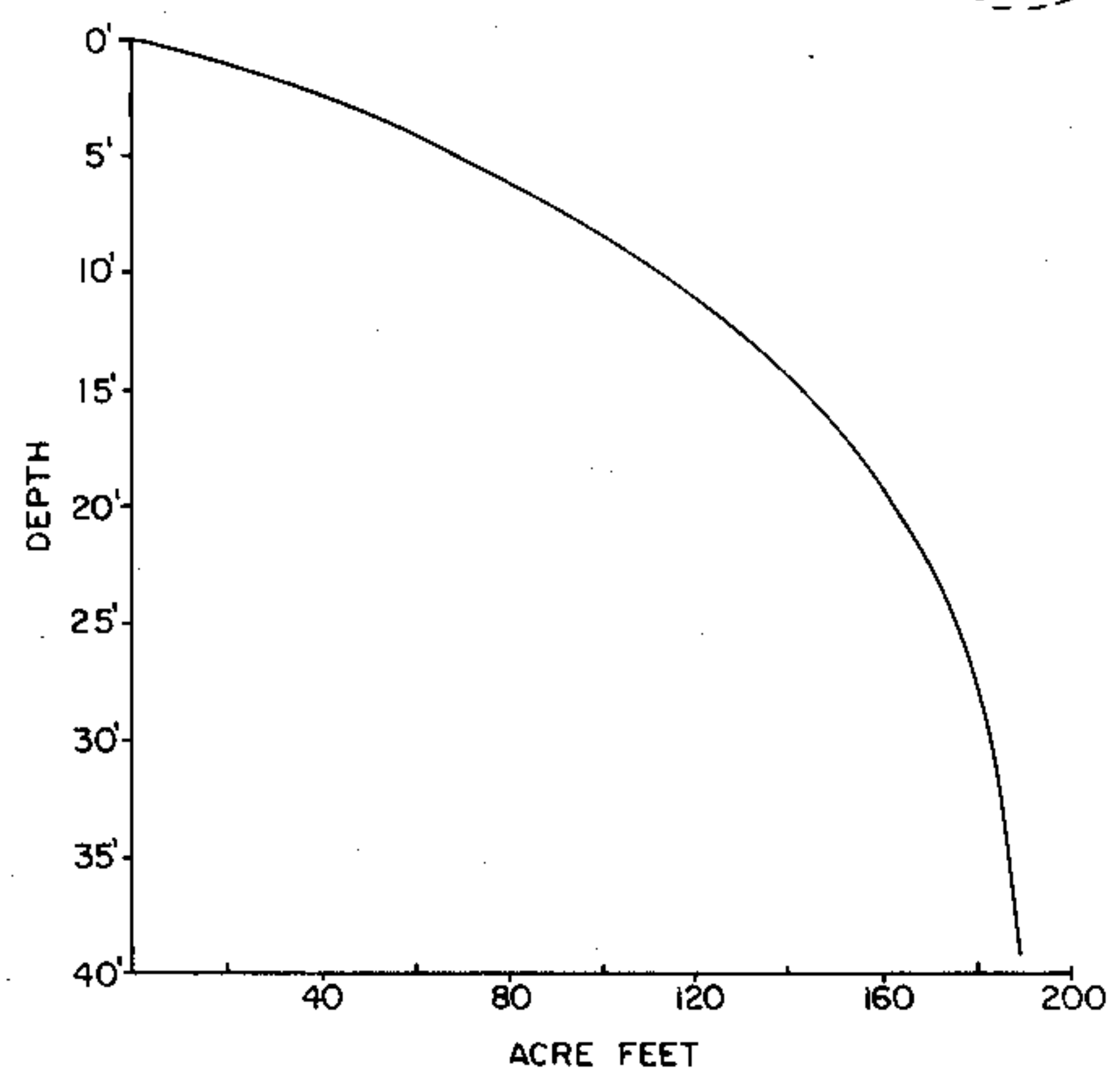
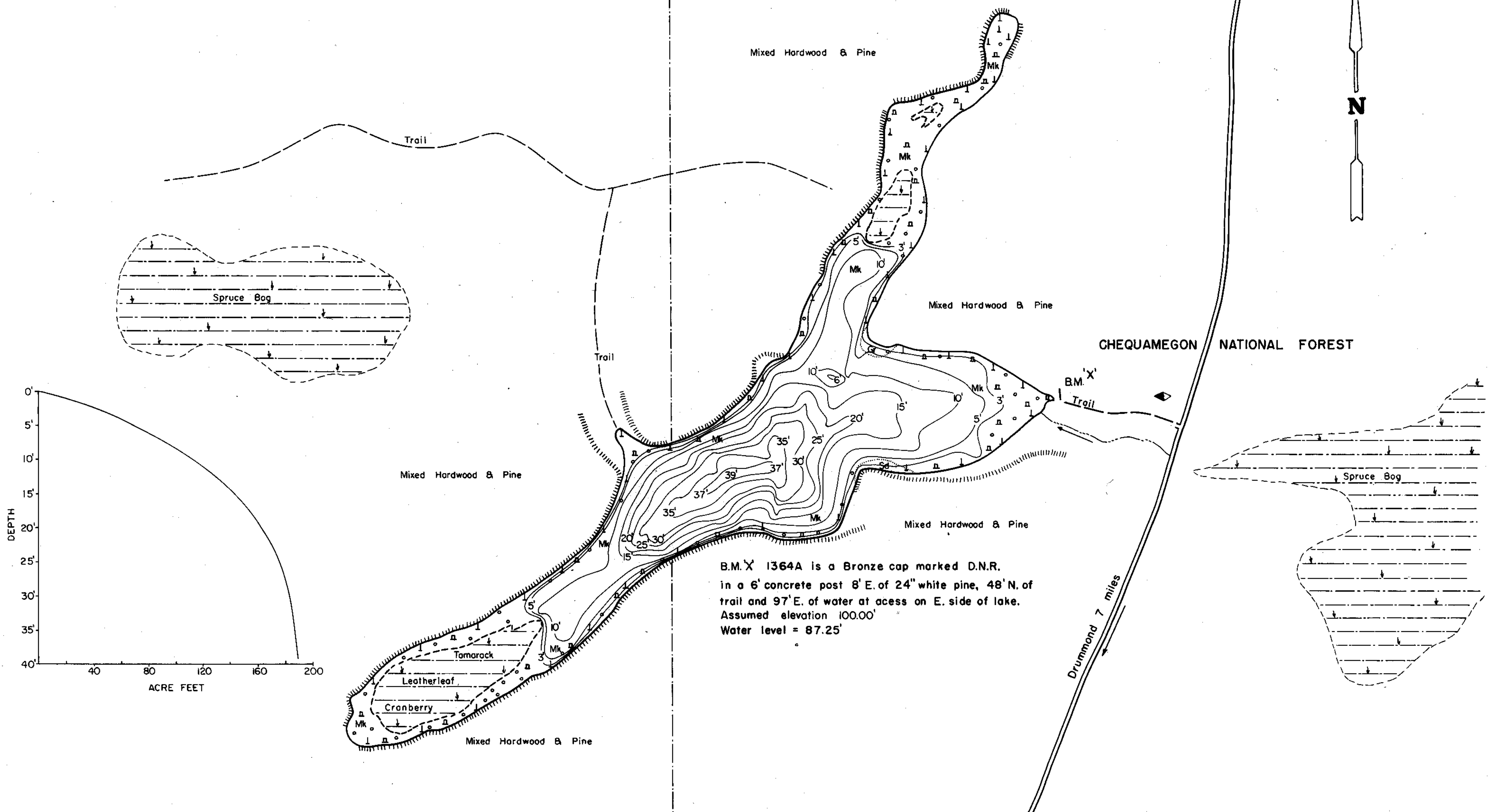


CHEQUAMEGON NATIONAL FOREST
