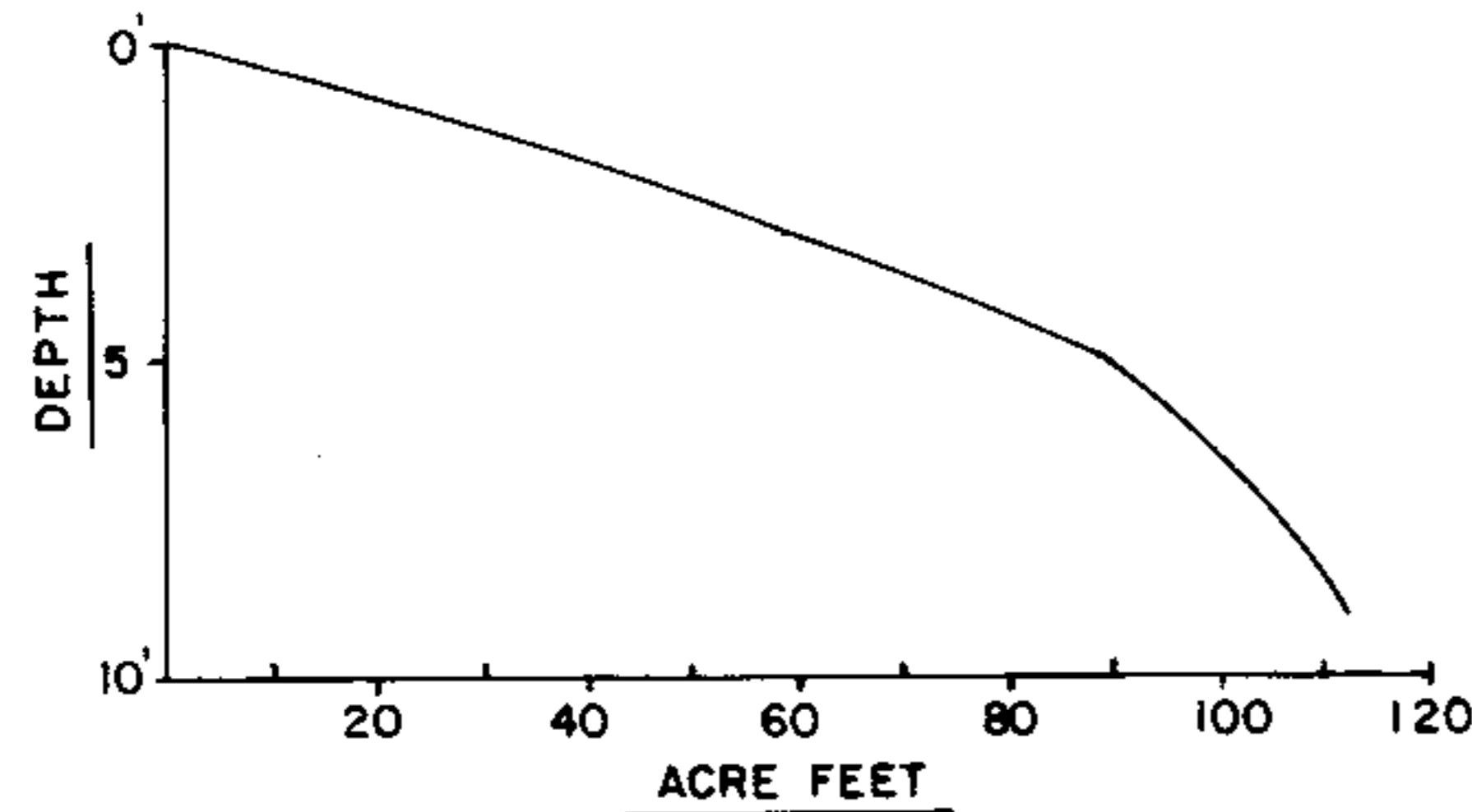
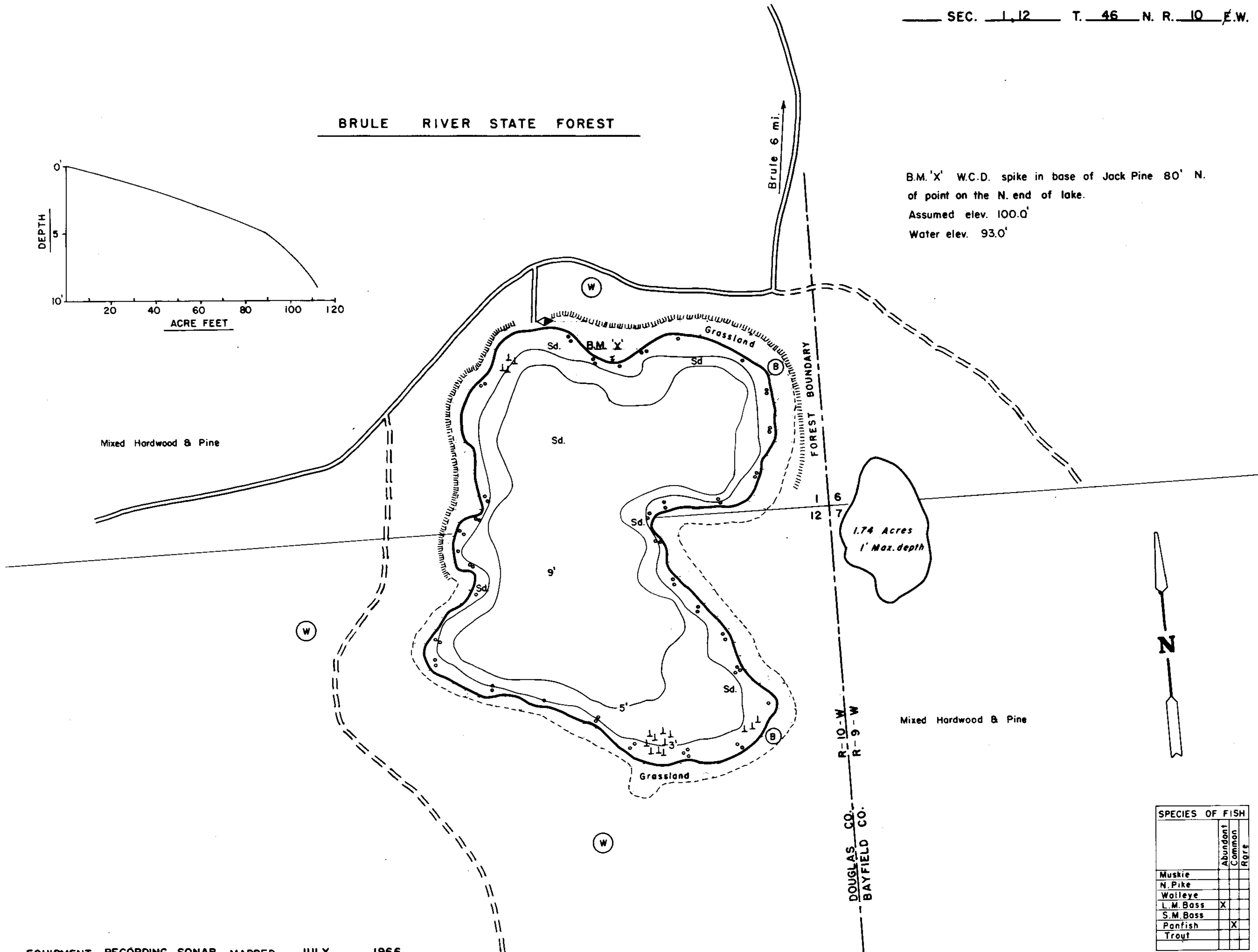

 Water elev. 93.0'

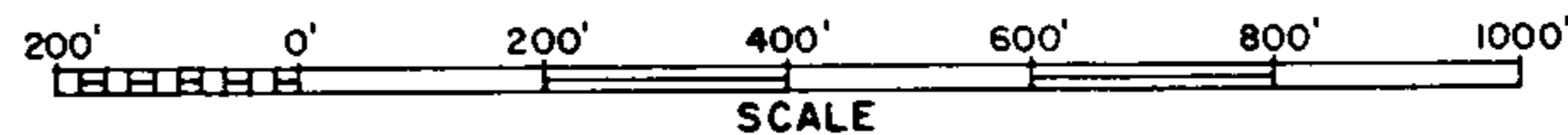
