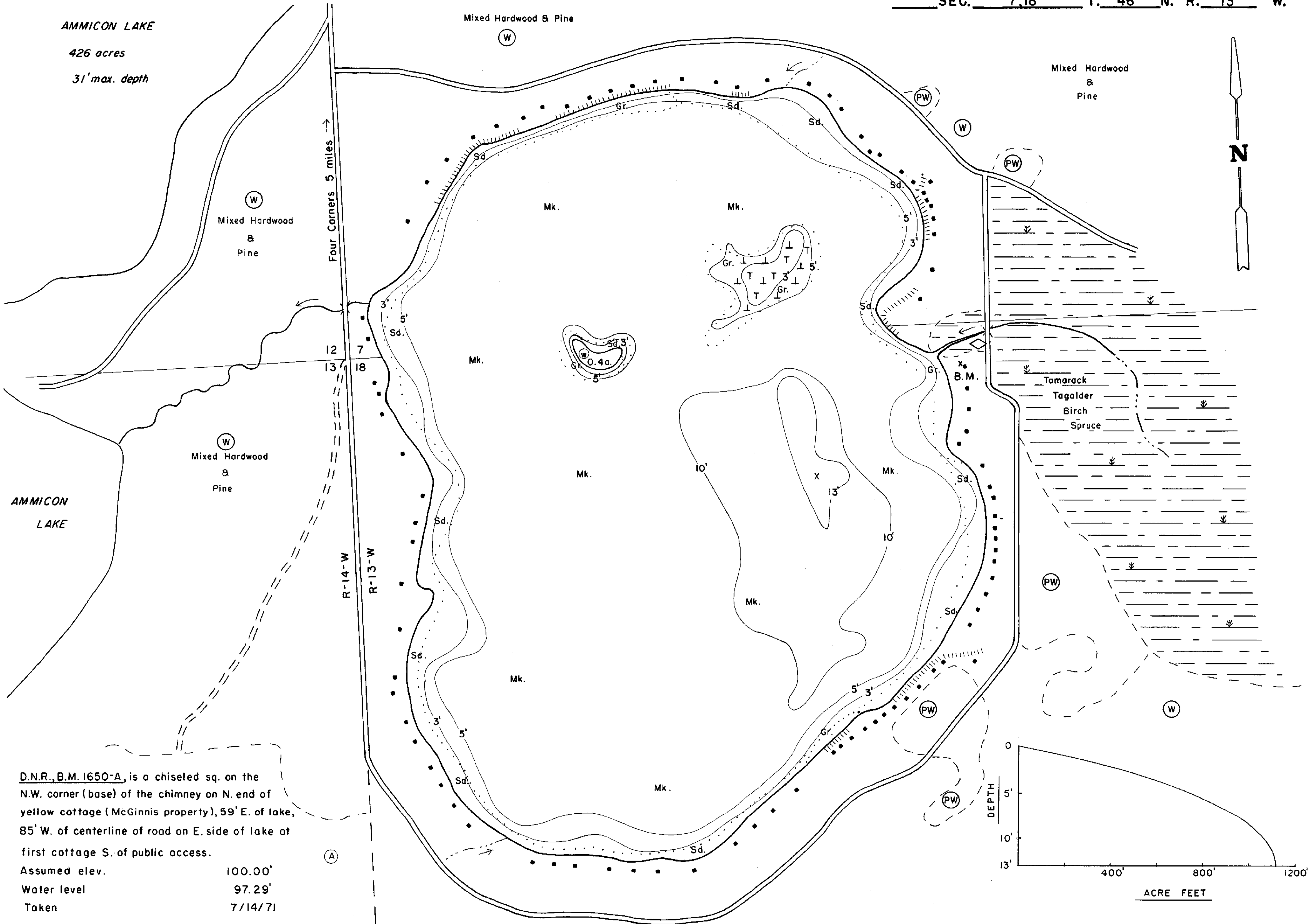


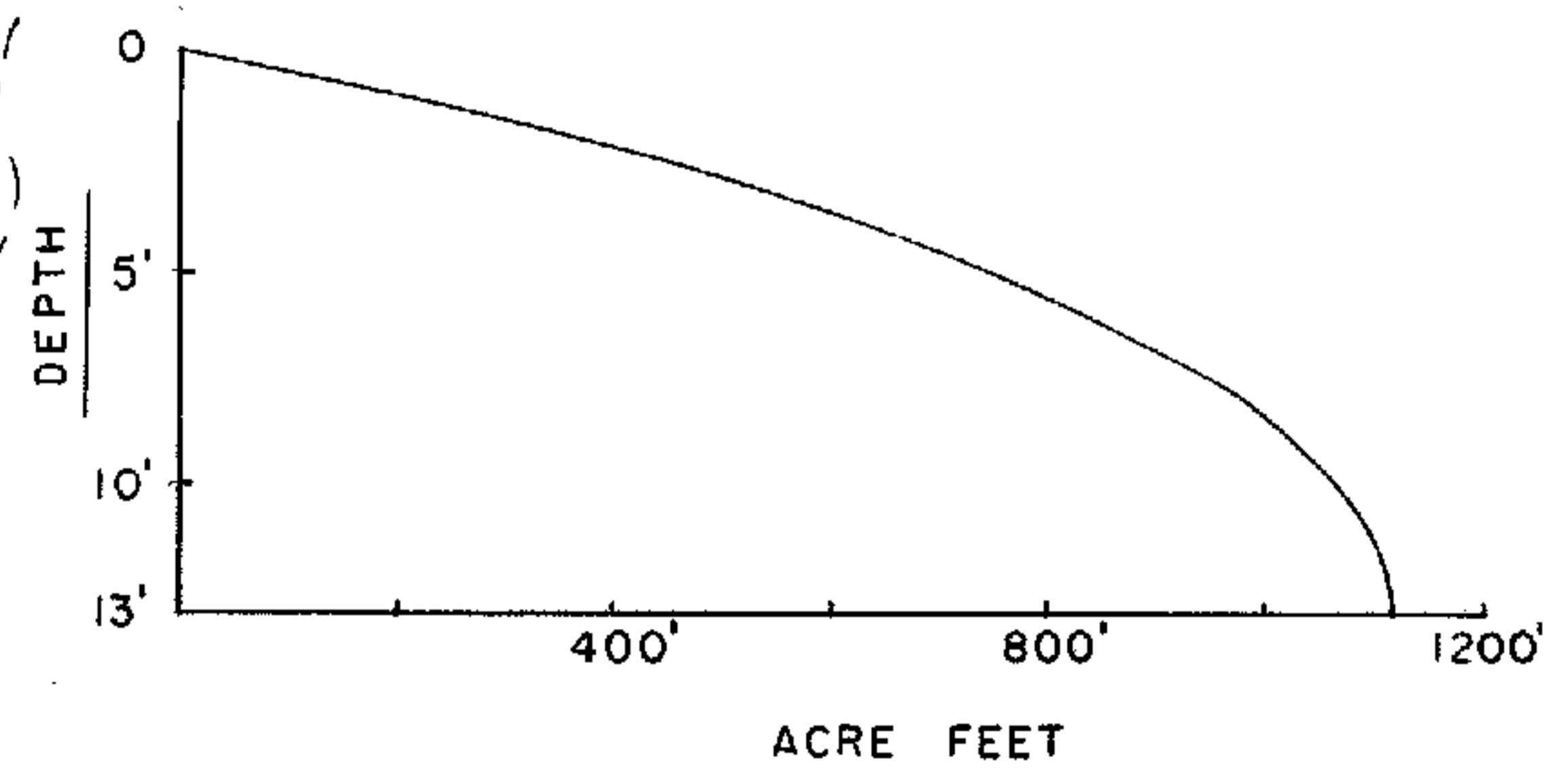
# LAKE SURVEY MAP
