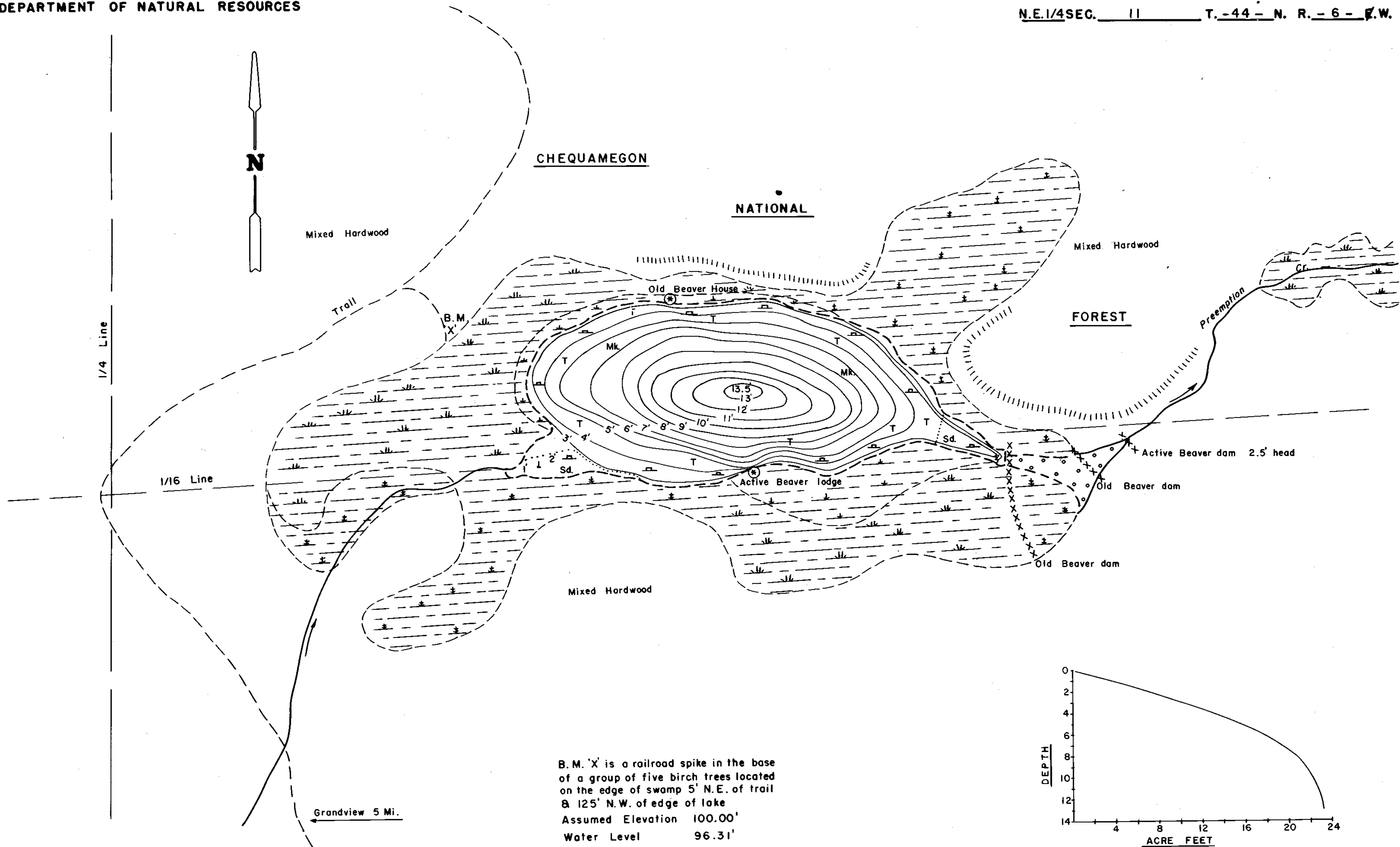
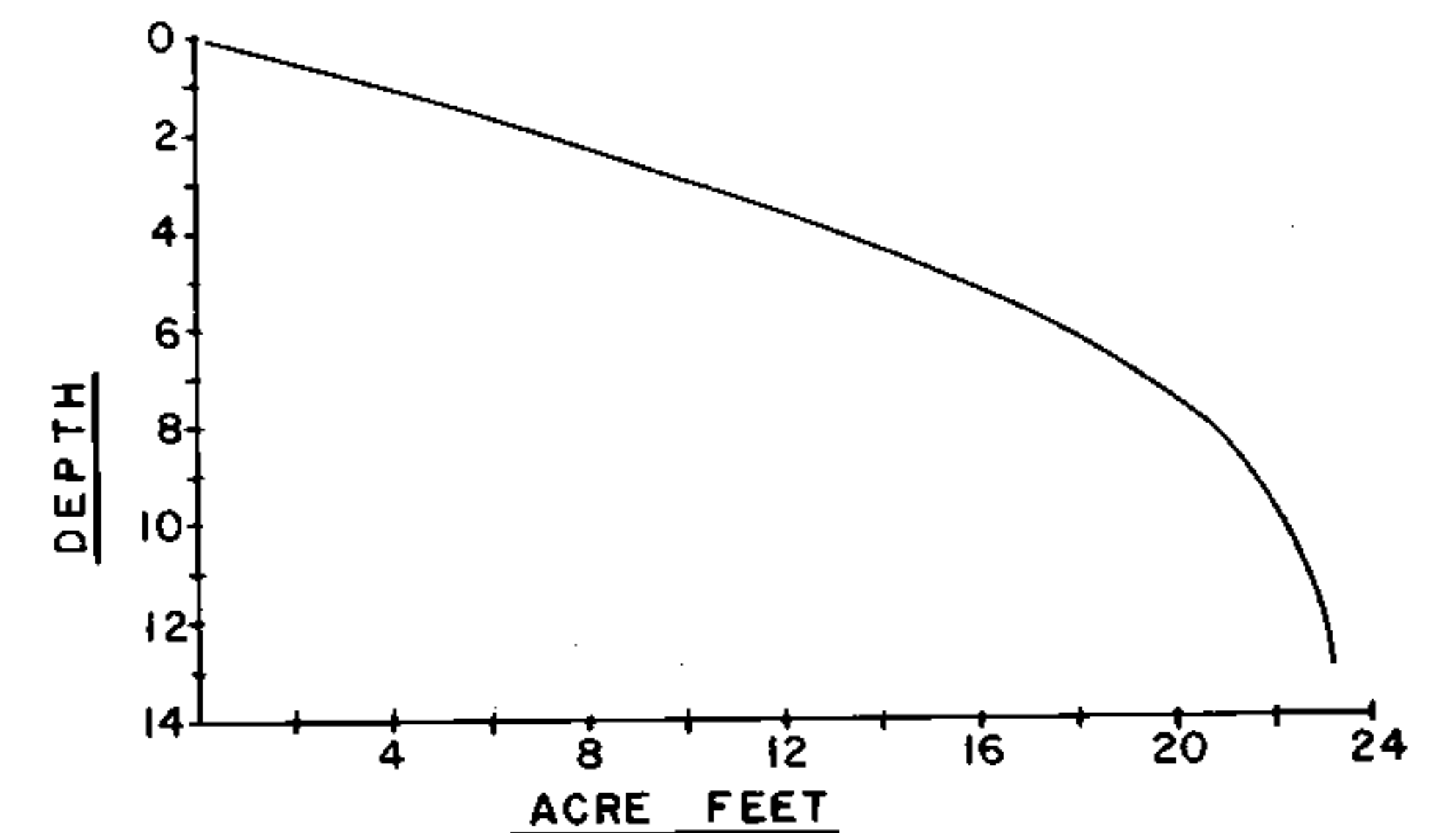


LAKE SURVEY MAP
