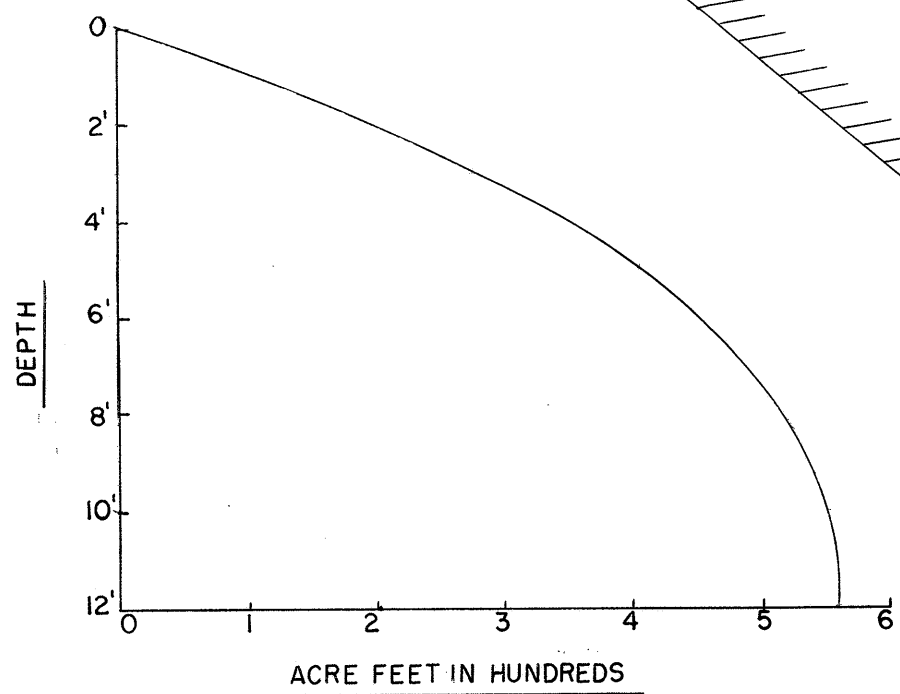


B.M. 'X' top of north spillway abutment

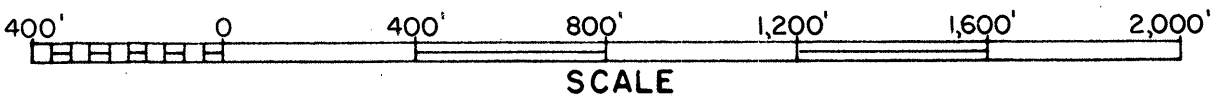
