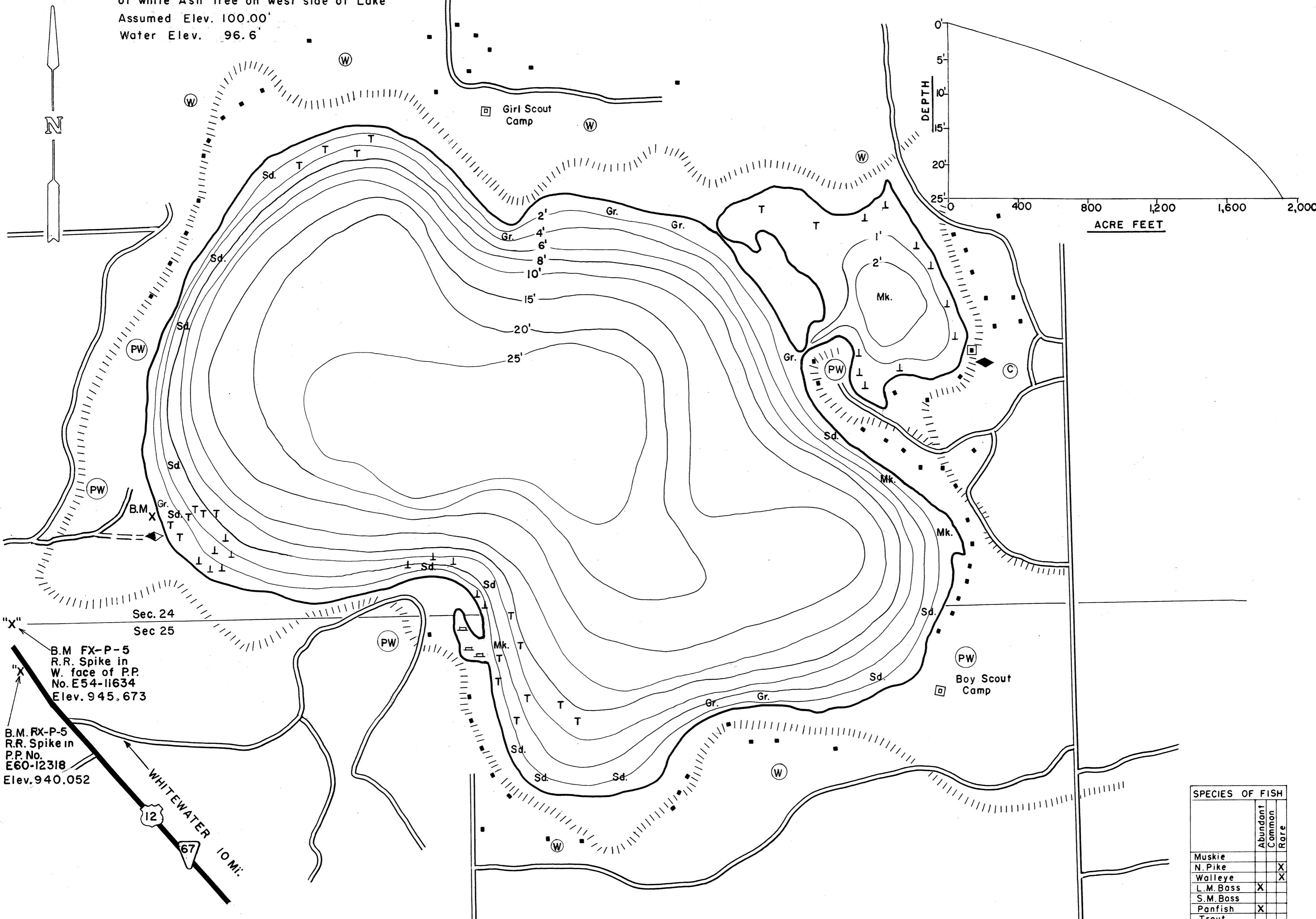


B.M. "X" Spike in south side in base of white Ash tree on west side of Lake

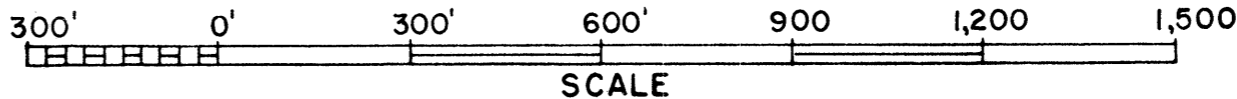
