

RAINBOW RESERVOIR


If you want to be among eagles, osprey, herons and loons, if you seek a serene, near-wilderness environment with great fishing, then you want to experience Wisconsin Valley Improvement Company's Rainbow Reservoir recreation area in Oneida County, north of Rhinelander.

Let this map be your guide to 4,165 acres of water recreation surrounded by 50 miles of rugged shoreline. Come and enjoy what many have cherished since the reservoir was developed on the main stem of the Wisconsin River in 1935.

It has been the policy of Wisconsin Valley Improvement Company (WVIC) to maintain the Rainbow in its natural, undeveloped state, and to make it accessible to you. Little has changed over the years. You are welcome as fisherman, hunter, hiker, naturalist and canoeist to use our flowage and bordering lands. We have provided boat landings, canoe portages and this map for your convenience.

Boaters, you are advised to travel at slow speeds on the reservoir because submerged rocks and snags could be hazardous. Water levels in the reservoir fluctuate seasonally. Consult the depth contour lines on the map for guidance.

We want to protect the unique character and solitude of these primitive surroundings, so we ask that you confine your camping to state and private campgrounds in the area. Fires are not permitted at the boat landings. Please don't litter, take it with you. Join with us as stewards of this natural resource and protect it from disturbance and misuse.
