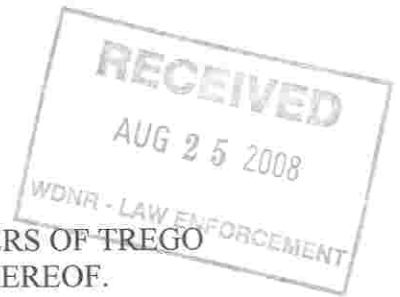

## ORDINANCE FOR SLOW-NO-WAKE AREA



A SOLE ORDINANCE TO REGULATE BOATING UPON THE WATERS OF TREGO FLOWAGE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

The Trego Town Board of the Town of Trego in Washburn County do ordain as follows:

### Section I. **Applicability and Enforcement**

- The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the waters of the Trego Flowage as approved for dredging, shown on the attached map.
- Enforcement shall be by the officers of the National Park Service.

### Section II **Intent**

To comply with the Department of the Army, St. Paul District, Corps of Engineers' special condition that is part of the authorization of this dredging project:

**"To minimize boat wake impacts to the wild rice beds, permittee shall have a No-Wake Zone ordinance enacted on the Trego Flowage. The controlled area shall include the rice beds and the open water areas within 100 yards of the rice beds, which are located on the reach of the flowage shown on the attached drawing. The permittee shall bear responsibility for purchasing and posting (annually) no-wake regulatory signs or buoys. This special condition shall remain in effect in perpetuity. The permittee shall ensure the ordinance is enacted by no later than September 30, 2008."**

### Section III **State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted**

State boating laws as found in ss. 30.50 to 30.71, Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

### Section IV **Definitions**

"Slow-no-wake" means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.

### Section V **Controlled Area**

No person shall operate a boat faster than slow-no-wake in the waters of Trego Flowage marked by no-wake buoys. Location of the six no-wake buoys are shown on attached map.

### Section VI **Posting Requirements**

The Town of Trego shall place and maintain a synopsis of this ordinance at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the Town pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15 WI Admin. Code.

**Section VII Penalties**


Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in Wis. Stat. 30.80, and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.

**Section VIII Severability**

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Trego Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

**Section IX Effective Date**

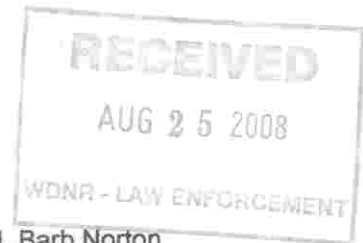
This section will become effective upon passage and the day after publication.

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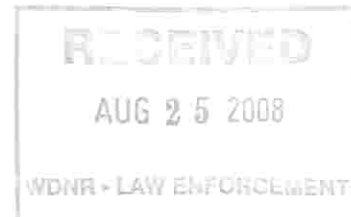


Town of Trego Board Meeting  
July 8, 2008

1. Chairman Campbell called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

3. Approval of minutes; Motion by Schmock to approve the minutes of June 10, 2008 and June 17, 2008, second by Huffer. Motion carried.

  - a. Trego Lake boat landing dock: Grant award has been received; dock and concrete pad have been placed.  
'ORDINANCE FOR SLOW-NO-WAKE AREA', a sole ordinance to regulate boating upon the waters of Trego Flowage and prescribing penalties for violations thereof was reviewed. Motion by Schmock to approve said ordinance, as indicated with attached map, second by Huffer. Motion carried. Dredging should take place the end of August or early September.
7. New business
  - a. Trego Lake District insurance: Insurance agent advised no coverage for different association. Agent was able to find an affordable policy for the District to insure under.
  - b. Request to use Town Hall – Mary Tripp, candidate for the 73<sup>rd</sup> Assembly District would like to host a 'Meet & Greet' session at the town hall on August 7<sup>th</sup>, 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. Board unanimously approved.
  - c. Operators License – Bethanie Holley: Motion by Schmock to approve operator's license for Bethanie Holley, second by Huffer. Motion carried.
  - d. Casual Labor – Jerry Werner is available for any work the town may have. The Chairman will contact Jerry regarding insurance. The Board will decide on hire date and wage at August meeting.
  - e. Open crack seal bids: The following bids were received:

    - \$ 4,830.00 Fahrner Asphalt Sealers
    - \$ 5,395.00 Allied Blacktop Corp.Motion by Schmock to accept Seal Coat Specialty's bid for \$3,610.38 (with 5-year warranty), second by Huffer. Motion carried.
  - f. ATV Ordinance amendment: The Board will review existing ordinance and current atv regulations for possible amendment at August meeting. Will determine the number of atv signs needed and place order.

  - a. Financial: June 30 bank balance \$12,471.72.

  - b. Other: Wes Huffer will be unavailable for Board of Review on July 12<sup>th</sup>; Ed Smith will take his place.
10. Road report
- a. Evergreen Excavating: patched, graded and placed gravel on Oakhill Road. No additional gravel to be placed at this time, patrolling will be done per request. Brushing and ditching needs to be done, the Board will inspect on Saturday before any work begins. Can start mowing anytime - rate is \$70.00/hour. Culvert on Robbins Road may need endwalls; Schaub Road needs fill. Blade patch on River Road will be done when material is available. Fill needs to be placed at River Road/Hwy 53 intersect.
  - b. Other: Oakhill Road has been pulverized. Jacobson Road was discussed; letter needs to be sent to property owner.
11. Correspondence: Notice from WDNR – MFL withdrawal tax due of \$6,949.16 for Spanel withdrawal (18.93 acres), payable by January 31, 2009.
12. Citizen Comment: Schedule conflict with Lake District/Board of Review on the 12<sup>th</sup>. Lake District will meet outside or at the park. River Road 40 mph speed limit is only posted on east end; sign is advisory only.
