

Town of Florence Ordinance #4-26-10

Exemption to the 100' Slow-No-Wake Restriction

Under the authority of ss 30.66(3)(ag)2, A SOLE ORDINANCE TO provide an exemption from the no-wake speeds, as defined in ss 30.66(3)(ag)1. This exemption applies only in the channels between lakes upon the waters of the Spread Eagle Chain of Lakes.

THEREFORE, The Town Board of the Town of Florence do ordain as follows:

SECTION I. Applicability and Enforcement

- a. The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the following Spread Eagle Chain of Lakes channels only: (Located in T40N R19E Sec. 32, 33 & 34; T39N R19E Sec. 4)
#1 North Lake/Middle Lake
#2 Middle Lake/Long Lake
#3 Middle Lake/Bass Lake
#4 Railroad Lake
- b. This chapter shall be enforced by the officers of the Florence County Sheriff's Department.

SECTION II: State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted

State boating laws as found in ss 30.50 to 30.71, Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

SECTION III: Posting Requirements

The Town of Florence shall place and maintain a synopsis of this ordinance at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the Town pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15 WI Admin. Code.


SECTION IV: Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and


the application of such provisions to other persons

publication.


