Ordinance No. 2011-1**

Exemption to the 100' Slow-No-Wake Restriction

Under the authority of ss 30.66(3)(ag)2, a SOLE ORDINANCE to provide an exemption from the slow-no-wake speeds as defined in ss 30.66(3)(ag)1. This exemption applies in the channel defined as the Narrows on the waters of Blue Spring Lake in the Town of Palmyra.

Therefore, the Town Board of the Town of Palmyra does ordain as follows:

Section I: Applicability and Enforcement

- a) The provisions of the Ordinance shall apply to Blue Spring Lake (Located in T 5N R 16E, Sections 27, 28 33 and 34)
- b) The officers of the Town of Palmyra shall enforce this Chapter.

Section II: Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests, and the capability of water resources.

Section III: State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted

State boating laws as found in ss 30.50 to 30.71, Wisconsin Statutes, are adopted by reference.

Section IV: Definitions

- 1. "Slow-no-wake" means that speed at which a boat moves slowly as possible while still maintaining steering control.
- 2. "Narrows" for the purposes of exemption under the authority of ss 30.66(3)(ag)2 means the channel located approximate 1/2 mile southwest of the public boat landing, and approximately 1/4 mile northeast of the dam/spillway on the west end of the lake, being approximately 600 feet in width. See attached map.

Section V: Posting Requirements

The Town of Palmyra shall place and maintain a synopsis of this ordinance at the public boat access ramp at Blue Spring Lake within the jurisdiction of the Town pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15 Wisconsin Administrative Code.

Section VI: Penalties

Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in Wisconsin Statutes 30.80, and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.

Section VI: Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting as provided by law.
