Lake Planning Grant Interim Report - May 1992	In 1990 the Wisconsin state legislature passed a bill that made monies available for lake planning grants to lake districts and lake associations. During the winter of 1990-91 the Wapogasset and Bear Trap Lake Association Lake Improvement Committee put together a plan and applied for a lake planning grant. A grant for \$11,506.70 was approved-on April 12, 1991. The state's share (75%) was \$8,630.03 and the our Lake Association's share (25%) was \$2,876.67. The project general description consists of six categories: 1.
