Eagle Lake - Lake Management Planning Grant	This report documents the results of a watershed-wide survey of Kansasville residents living in the Eagle Lake Watershed. The study was conducted in the fall of 1991, and revealed a high degree of environmental awareness among these residents. While passive recreational pursuits dominated the lake-related activities (viewing and walking), many respondents used the lake for swimming and boating, Most expressed concern over poor water quality and a declining fishery, even though frequent anglers were a minority of the surveyed population. This study found that most residents were concerned about nonpoint source pollution from the watershed.
