The planning area is located in the northwest-central part of Dodge County, Wisconsin and includes the City of Beaver Dam Which is the county's largest municipality. The planning area is tributary to Crystal Creek, the Beaver Dam Lake, the Beaver Dam River, and is within the limits of the "Upper" Rock River Basin. The Rock River flows thru Dodge County and southern Wisconsin, then into Illinois, where it ultimately meets the Mississipi River at the Illinois-lowa state border.
