Water samples will be analyzed for a suite of inorganic water quality parameters by the Wisconsin State Lab of Hygiene. In addition, a one time top/bottom paleolimnological core will be collected and evaluated. Watershed analysis data provided by Barron County will be evaluated to determine areas of concern within the watershed. Data from this grant will be combined with existing and future data to help determine the best way to manage Granite Lake to improve or maintain water quality, lake-user

satisfaction, and the overall health of the system.

Deliverables include paper and electronic (digital) copies of the Comprehensive Report including: 1) Final Report summarizing the accomplishments of the grant; 2) A Summary document of the results and evaluation of the paleo-core; 3) All raw data pertaining to lake and stream water quality monitoring, including data from the two surface water sites being submitted to the Wisconsin Surface Water Inventory Management System (SWIMS); 4) Copies of and evaluation of the original Barron County Granite Lake watershed analysis to be used to assist in future development of a hydrologic and nutrient budget for the lake.
