Special conditions: The sponsor shall immediately contact the DNR if a new aquatic invasive species infestation is found. WDNR's Aquatic Plant Management in Wisconsin guidance should be followed for point-intercept survey monitoring and aquatic plant management plan development. Draft public surveys should be reviewed by the Department before distribution.
