In Phase I, participants learned about the lake and the landscape. Success of future phases depends on a coalition of participants, each carrying out appropriate tasks and communicating needs and findings to other team members. It is appropriate that the Lake Alice Association (LAA) is the lead organization in this long-range effort. This document represents the Phase I product of Lake Alice Stewardship Program with funding from a Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) Lake Planning Grant awarded to LAA. White Water Associates, Inc. (White Water), an independent environmental laboratory and ecological consulting firm, was contracted by LAA to carry out significant aspects of the Phase I project. Phase I focused on an inventory of relevant information on Lake Alice and its surroundings and produced the first iteration of an Adaptive Lake Management Plan.
