- 2) Water quality sampling following CLMN protocols (Secchi, P, Chla)
- 3) Curly-leaf pondweed survey
- 4) Aquatic plant community mapping and analysis
- 5) Fisheries assessment
- 6) Watershed assessment
- 7) Develop LMP

- 2) Aquatic plant community and watershed maps
- 3) LMP
