Information required as part of an existing I&E program (e.g. Clean Boats Clean Waters) must be entered in the statewide database (if applicable); 7) County-wide network/resource list, including lake contacts, monitors, volunteers, etc.; 8) Examples of educational/outreach materials; 9) Summary & examples of press releases, newsletter articles, & other media contacts.

Special Conditions: New identification of aquatic invasive species must be immediately reported to the Department.
