All comments received by DNR at the hearing and all written comments received by DNR at the hearing and prior to the close of the 30-day public comment period will be considered by DNR prior to making a final decision regarding the air pollution control operation permit renewal. After the public hearing, a final decision will be made on whether to proceed with issuance or deny the air pollution control permit.
