The Department issued a Notice of Discharge on April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013 for a Category III discharge that caused contamination of groundwater. The probable source of contamination originated from a field, located at T 2-3N R19E N1/2 Section 10, which received manure from your farm.

On June 16, 2014, the Department received notification from the Racine County Soil and Water Conservation Department that all actions set forth in the NOD have been satisfied. At this time, with the completion of the required actions, the Department deems the concerns listed in the April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013 Notice of Discharge satisfied.

Please note that any future discharge to Waters of the State will be violation of Chapter NR 243, Wisconsin Administrative Code, and additional actions will be required of the landowner regardless of whether cost-share funding is made available.
