Dear Mr. Larsen,

Enclosed please find a final grant report and documentation for the CBCW Lake Nancy/Kimball Lake CBCW & Education Project.

This year the project consisted almost exclusively of the monitoring activity at the Kimball Lake landing and the Nancy Lake landing at the Deeper Lake site and the production and mailing of some educational materials. I have included data on the number of boats monitored on each lake and the people encountered. We monitored more boats than we have in any previous year that we have participated in the CBCW program. Perhaps this was due partly to the nice summer and partly due to the fact that we monitored for more hours. However, our average # of boats monitored this summer was higher than any previous year also. All the SWIMS data entry has been completed.

I have attached here one of the educational mailings sent to Kimball residents. In an earlier report I attached a mailing sent to residents on both lakes.

We had one incident this summer at the Kimball landing which was unpleasant for our monitors. Two boaters arrived with weeds attached to their trailer. They refused to answer any questions and insulted the monitors. They proceeded to launch the boat. Subsequently, they wrote a letter to the DNR complaining that the monitors were "forcing" them to answer questions. In any case, I corresponded with Jeff Bode, DNR Madison, and Dave Swanson, Washburn Conservation Officer, about this incident.

If I have failed to provide any necessary information for our report, please let me know.
