Howard Johnson's Effluent Limits

I've conducted a minimal field investigation and also a search of our fish distribution data files to determine the stream classifications for the three streams in the vicinity of Howard Johnson's. Under the new classification scheme, all three streams, the Des Plaines River main stem, the Des Plaines River Center Branch and the Kilbourn Road Ditch, are classified as Use Class B in the vicinity of Howard Johnson's. This means they are capable of supporting warm water sport fish and thus full fish and aquatic life standards apply.

I have also conducted a check of the Pleasant Prairie Ditch classification. A report is included on this in a separate memo.
