Wastewater Receiving Stream Classification

The Loyal WWTP discharge is to Bear Creek about 3.75 miles upstream from the confluence with Rock Creek.

Extensive agricultural land use within the Bear Creek watershed is a potential threat to good water quality. However, at CTH "K", above the WWTP, the observation of minnows on August 25, 1975, attested to the intermediate aquatic life status of Bear Creek at that site. Marsh land and vegetative protection adjacent to much of the stream probably serves to maintain fair water quality in the low gradient stream.

Dry stream conditions are known to exist above the Loyal WWTP and may persist all the way to Rock Creek under severe, dry weather circumstances. Observations at the section 5/8, east-west town road, 2 miles below the WWTP have always noted the presence of stream flow. Marsh land present near the section 5/8 town road crossing is potential northern pike spawning area during the spring of the year.

Recommendations:

Bear Creek shall be classified as a noncontinuous intermediate aquatic life stream upstream from the east - west town road on the section 5/8 section line. From that point downstream to Rock Creek the classification shall be continuous flow, fish and aquatic life.

The fish and aquatic life classification of the downstream is dependent upon a continuous flow hydrologic status during the majority of any given ten-year period. Physical supporting conditions for higher fish and aquatic life are believed to exist.




