<u>Davy Creek</u> - Surface Acres = 2.6 Miles, Miles = 4.3, Gradient = 11.6 feet per mile.

Davy Creek is a tributary to the Rock River. Davy Creek flows northwest of Ashippun and enters a large marshland before joining with the Rock River. This marsh is highly valued as a northern pike spawning ground and should be maintained at its present high quality.

Recommendations

Davy Creek in its entirety should be classified continuous fish and aquatic life.
