Spring Brook - Surface Acres = 3.4 Miles, Miles = 5.1, Gradient = 7.4 feet per mile.

Spring Brook originates from springs one mile southwest of Burnett and flowing into the Horicon Marsh. Because of its springs it provides both a high dissolved oxygen rate and high water quality to the lakes.


Recommendations

From the proposed Burnett Sanitary District discharge and for the remainder of Spring Brook the classification should be continuous fish and aquatic life.

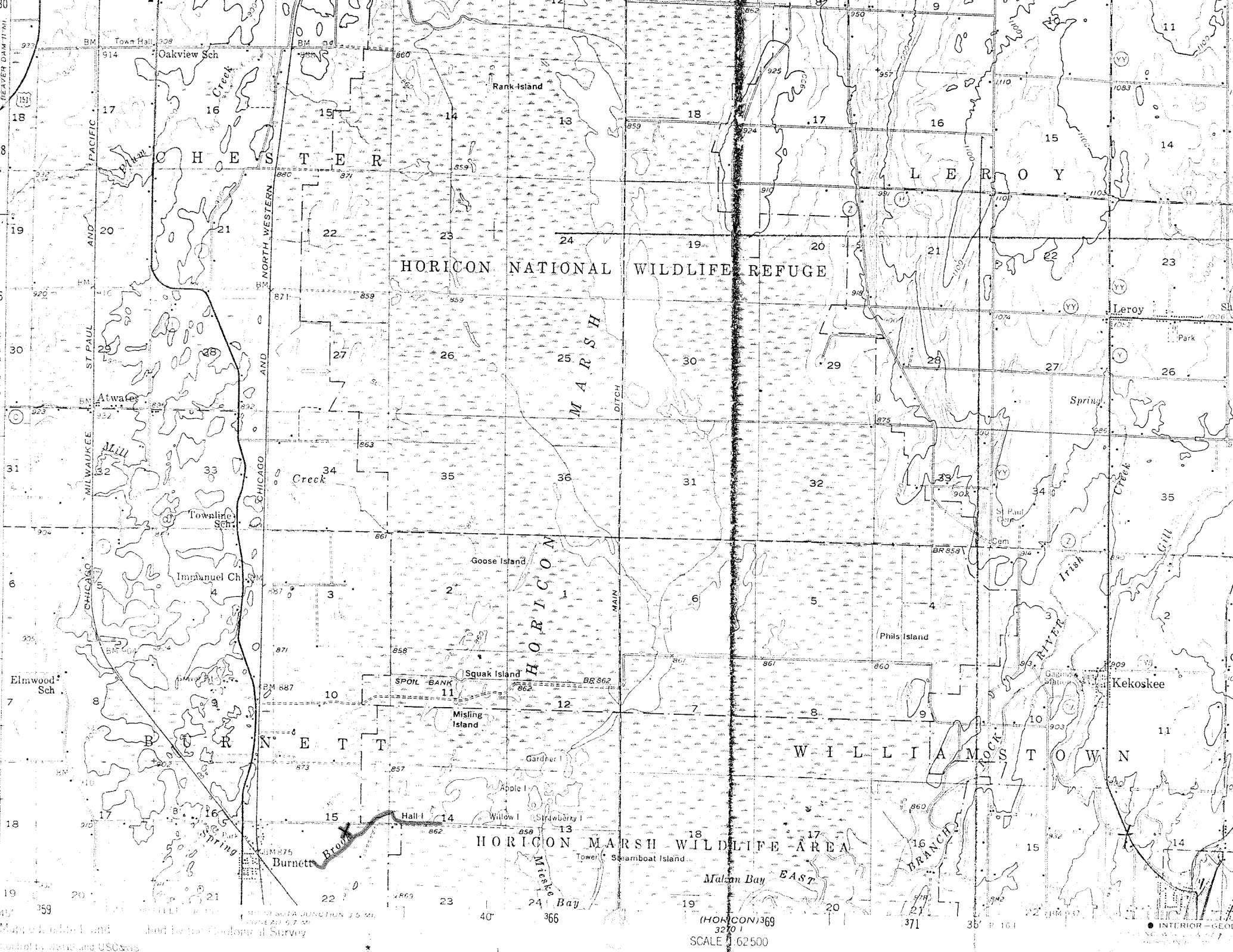
