
WASTEWATER RECEIVING STREAM CLASSIFICATION

Survey Date: 6-23-76

The Village of Saint Cloud operates a two-cell aerated lagoon wastewater treatment facility followed by a polishing pond. Effluent from the plant is discharged through 430 feet of eight inch pipe to the Sheboygan River. The Sheboygan River has extensive growths of aquatic weeds both above and below the treatment plant outfall during the summer months (see photos).

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Sheboygan River is classified as a continuous fish and aquatic life stream below the Saint Cloud Wastewater Treatment facility.
