Milk Specialties, Inc., discharges cooling water and treated process wastewater to Crooked Creek via a one-third mile pipe. The discharge is .7 of a mile upstream of the confluence with the Wisconsin River. Crooked Creek is presently being managed as a trout stream.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Crooked Creek in its entirety should be classified as a continuous fish and aquatic life stream.
