Treated process water and cooling waters from the Milk Specialties Company are discharged to Skinner Creek .9 of a mile above the confluence with the Pecatonica River. Skinner Creek is a continuous stream managed for smallmouth bass, channel catfish and forage fish species. The Pecatonica River also exhibits a high quality fishery with smallmouth bass and channel catfish being predominate.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The entire length of Skinner Creek should be classified as continuous fish and aquatic life.
