

Kickapoo Oil Refining Company - Marquette County

Wastewater Receiving Stream Classification

Survey Date: 7-11-77

The Kickapoo Oil Refining Company plans to erect a distillation column east of Oxford on State Highway "23". This facility would have a wastewater treatment system that would consist of a oil/water seperator followed by a RBS treatment plant. The discharge would be directed to an intermittant stream which flows under the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad tracks and travels for about three miles through farm land before reaching Neenah Creek. At the time of our survey, the stream was dry. Neenah Creek is a trout stream from Oxford down to the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, T. 15 North, R. 8 East. This is approximately one mile below the junction of the intermittant stream with Neenah Creek.

Recommendations

The intermittant stream which flows from the Kickapoo Oil Refining Company site shall be classified as a marginal surface water until its confluence with Neenah Creek. Neenah Creek shall be classified as a continuous, fish and aquatic life stream.


