Wastewater Receiving Stream Classification

Pickle-Rite, Inc., a pickle processing operation, discharges its wastes into a tributary to the Little Suamico River. Wastewater is discharged during spring and fall months upon the approval of the Department of Natural Resources from three fill and draw lagoon cells. The tributary originates just west of Pickle-Rite and flows approximately 1 1/2 miles to the Little Suamico River.

At State Highway "32" there appeared to be no flow with a sandy bottom and some lily-pads. The stream bed here has at some time in the past been dug for surface drainage reasons. Below the industrial discharge the stream bed is silty lending a cloudy appearance to the water. Pools of standing water are characteristic of below Pickle-Rite. Adjoining land use is mostly agricultural.

Recommendation:


The tributary to the Little Suamico River is determined to be classified as a noncontinuous, agricultural use stream.
