Continuous, fish and aquatic life.

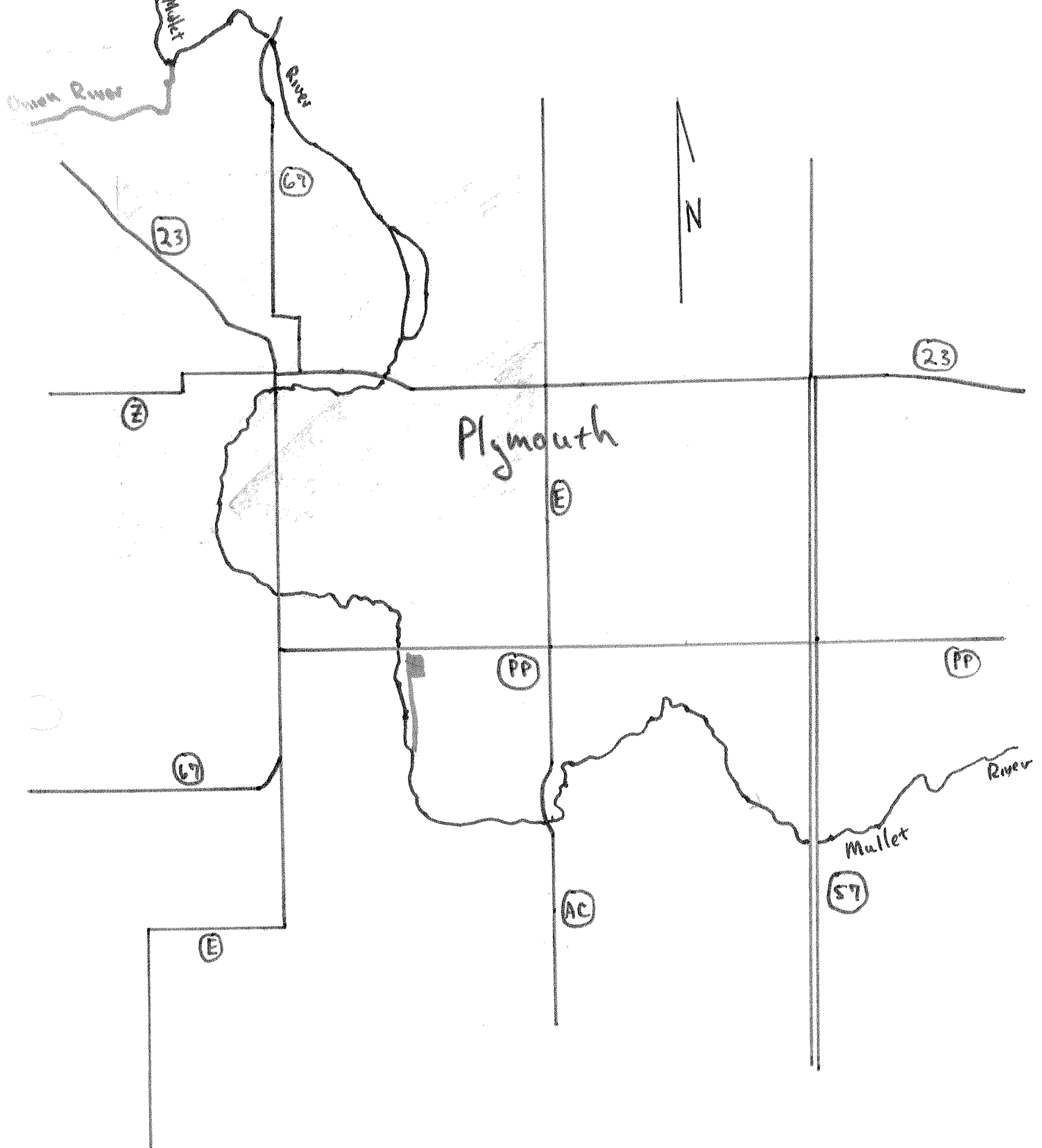
